Beyond BOW KAYAKING Grand Island!

CLASS DESCRIPTION AND OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION

This one day event is geared toward women that have experience in kayaking but would like to expand on it. This event will start at the Grand Island Landing west of Munising. We will leave there at 9 a.m. We expect participants to be there no later than 8:30 a.m. so we can make sure everyone is set for the kayak. There will be a total of 6 hours of paddling. Please make sure you feel fit enough to do this. We will plan on arriving at Trout Bay by noon for lunch (Little Dunes 1 & 2) and then back to the Landing by 4 p.m.

We will paddle—weather permitting-- from Grand Island Landing west of Munising on the mainland across the channel aiming for Wick Point and then in front of the East Channel Light house heading north up the shore to Trout Point. This can be a tricky spot because often waves are breaking at that point and all paddlers need to be prepared to be wet from waves. Once we've rounded the point it's usually a following sea down to Trout Bay where we would lunch. Then take the trip back.

All paddlers have to be prepared for a 6 hour paddle. This is a beautiful paddle on Lake Superior, we will be traveling to a remote area on an island therefore **all must have experienced a successful wet exit and know how to re-enter their boat with help.** The instructors will contact everyone ahead of time to make sure you have enough experience for this workshop.

All boats must be **SEA** kayaks with front & rear bulkheads. Spray skirts are mandatory as well as wet suits, pump, paddle float and PFD. Again, rounding Trout Point paddlers are likely to get wet from waves.

All paddlers also need to bring water, snack, sunscreen, and sunglasses.
Some other items you may want bring would be:

Dry Bag to stow your gear
Change of clothes (for the ride home w/dry towel - you will most likely get wet)
Pair of shoes that can get wet for the kayak
Camera

Uncle Ducky's in Munising does kayak rentals - if you do not have your own - 906-228-5447 - this location is right near the launch site.
