

Where do the Naturalist Programs begin?

NOTE:

- Pouring rain, lightning or high winds will cancel an outdoor program.
- The astronomy program requires nearly clear skies.
- Long pants for insect protection, especially in early summer, are highly recommended for all interpretive hikes.
- Interpretive activities begin at locations throughout the park, remember to include "travel time."
- Check your watch, part of the park is on Eastern Time, part is on Central Time.

Presque Isle Campground

Cloud Peak Hike
Begins on M-107
1/4 mile west of mine site picnic area

Adventurous Stick Your Head In A Bear Den
Begins on M-107,
1/4 mile west of Government Peak Trailhead

Michigan Mammals, Union Bay Crafts, Bones Fur and Poop, & Shining Big Sea Water
all begin at Union Bay Campground playground

Giants of the North & Calls of the Wild
begin at the Wilderness Visitor Center

Astronomy - Begins at the Lake of the Clouds Overlook

Michigan Gray Wolf Hike
Meet at Government Peak Trailhead


Stick Your Head In A Bear Den
Begins on South Boundary Road. Watch for signs.

Archery in the Park
Meet at Ski hill under the chair lift.

Aquatic Insect Hike
Begins at the Union Mine Interpretive Trail.

Summit Peak Hike
Begins at the Summit Peak Parking Area

Nonesuch Hike
Begins at "Nonesuch Corner," a sharp bend in the South Boundary Road about 4 miles south of the Wilderness Visitor Center. Look for a small gravel road on the east side of the South Boundary Road.
