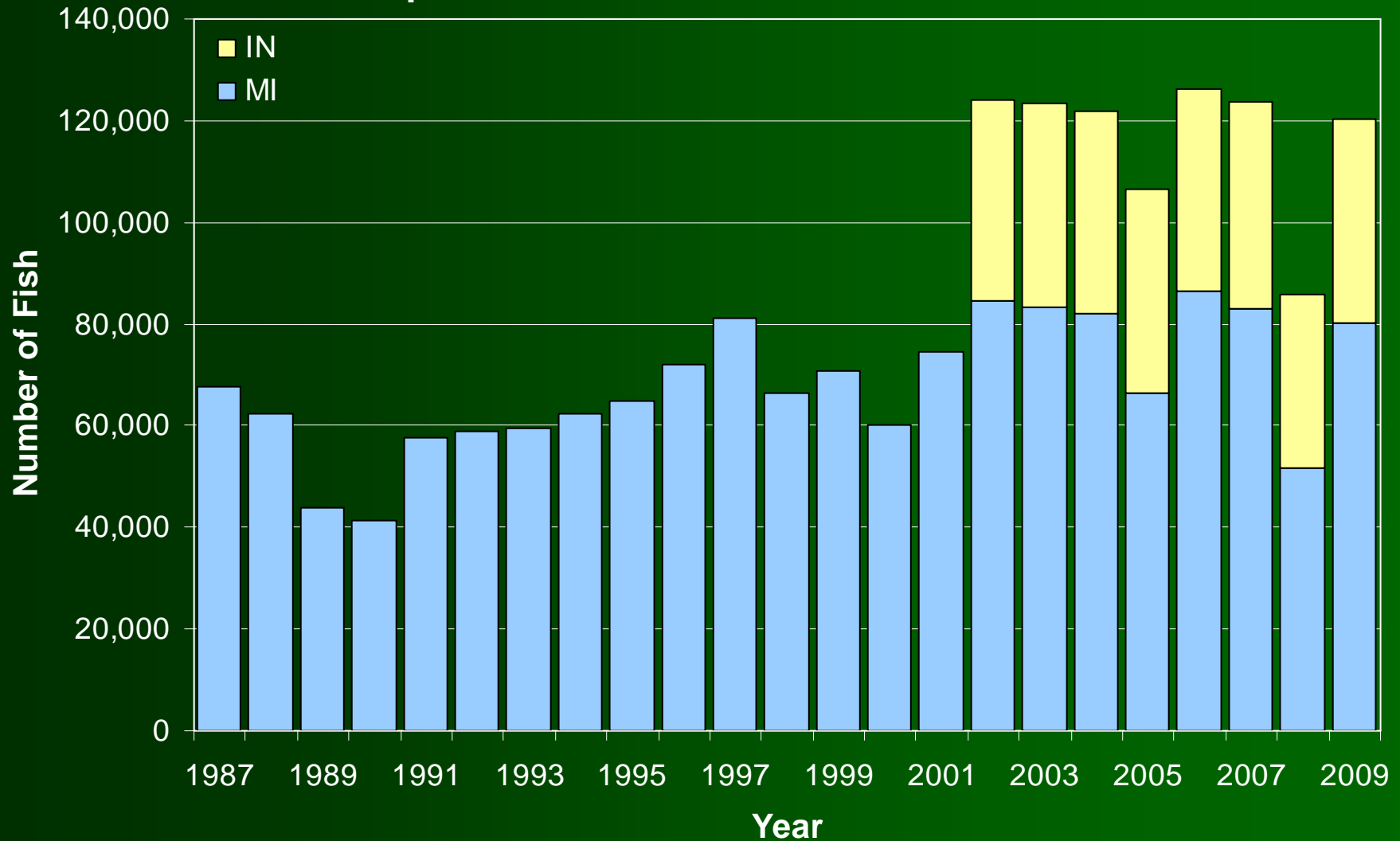
## Definitions

Fall fingerling – fish that is in the fall of its first year of life

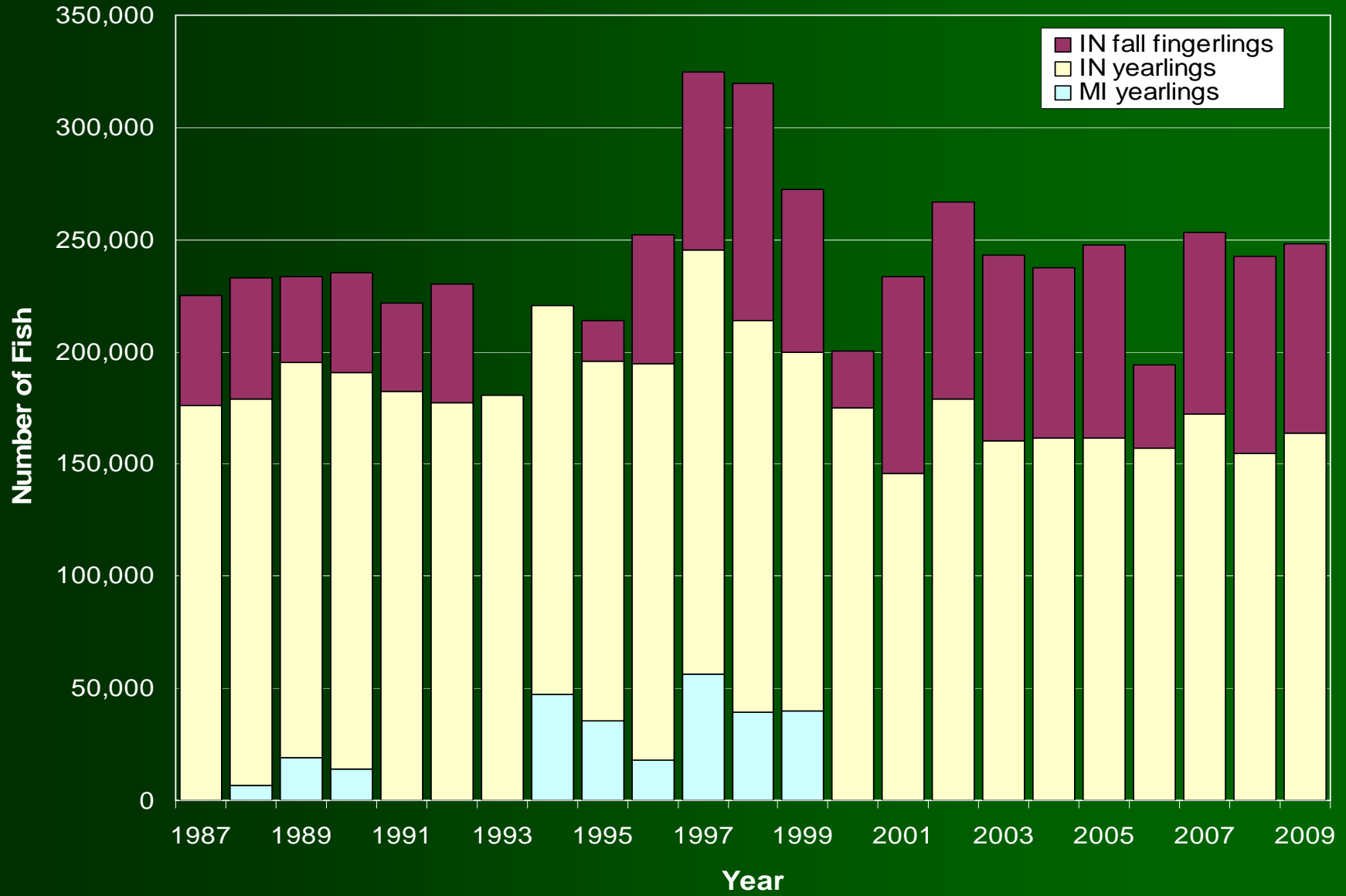
Spring fingerling – fish that is in the spring or summer of its first year of life

Yearling – fish that is in its second year of life, which is defined to start on  
January 1

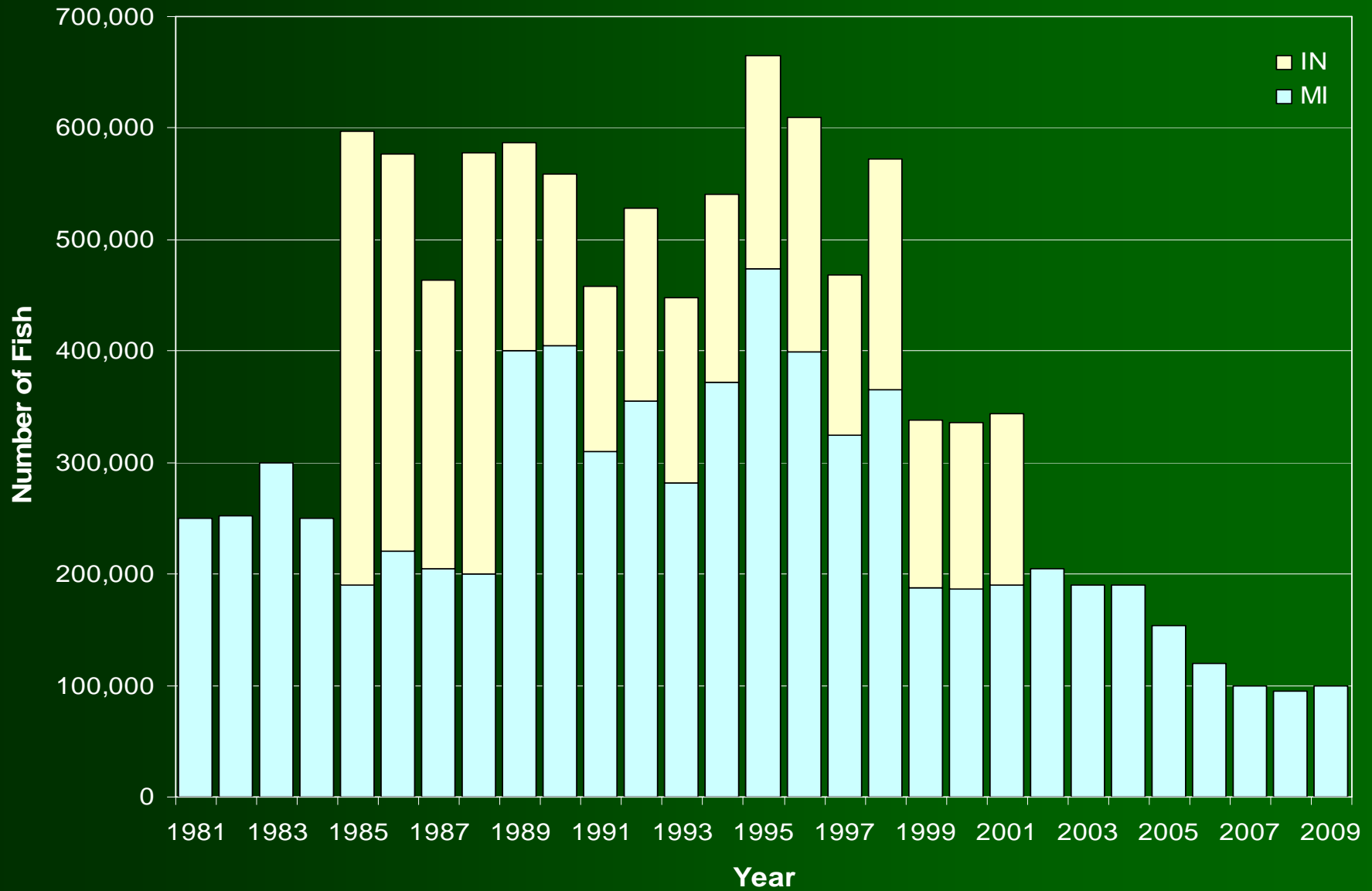
## Yearling Steelhead (Michigan Strain) Stocked in the St. Joseph River and the Lower Paw Paw River



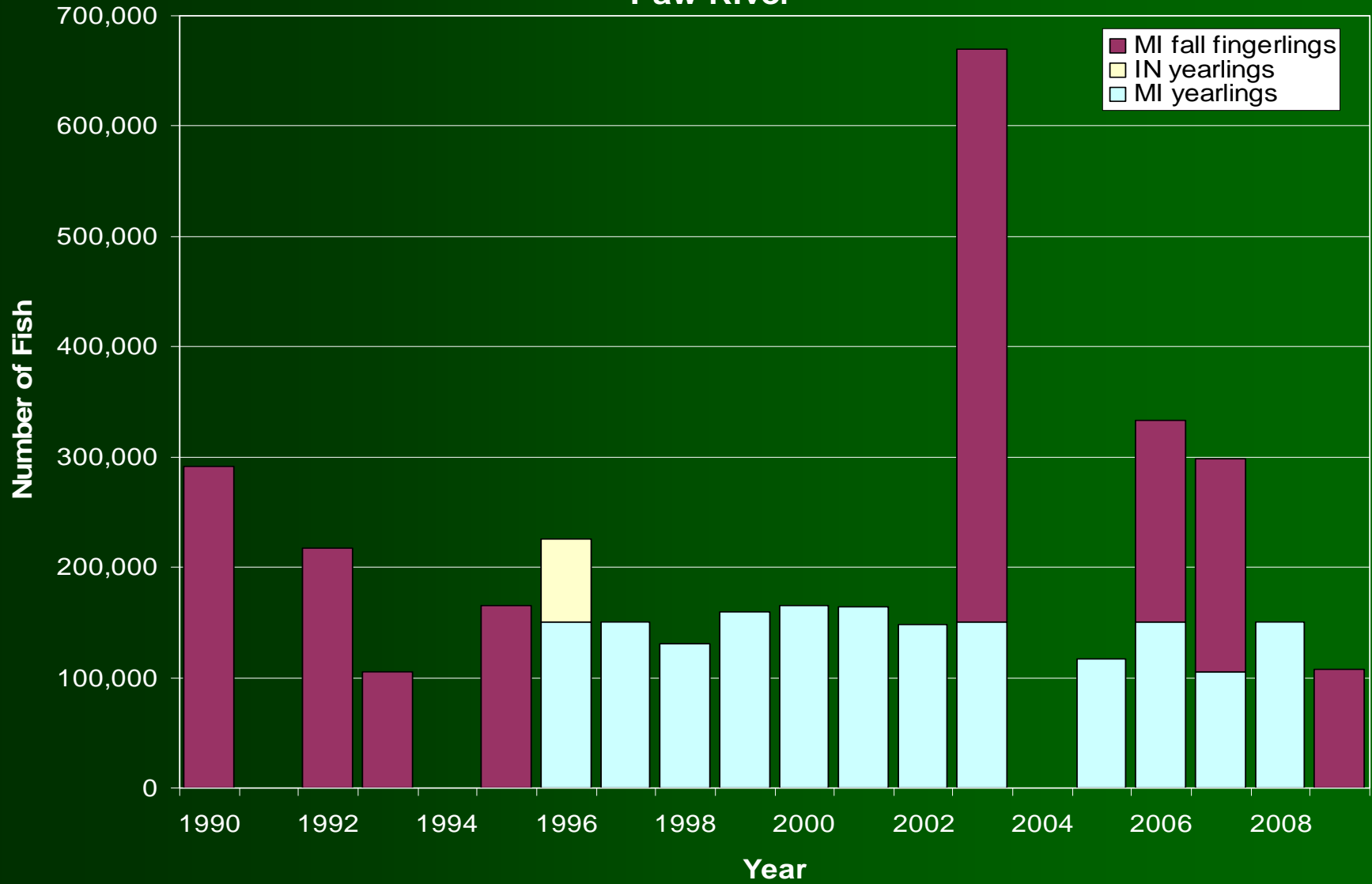
## Steelhead (Skamania Strain) Stocked in the St. Joseph River



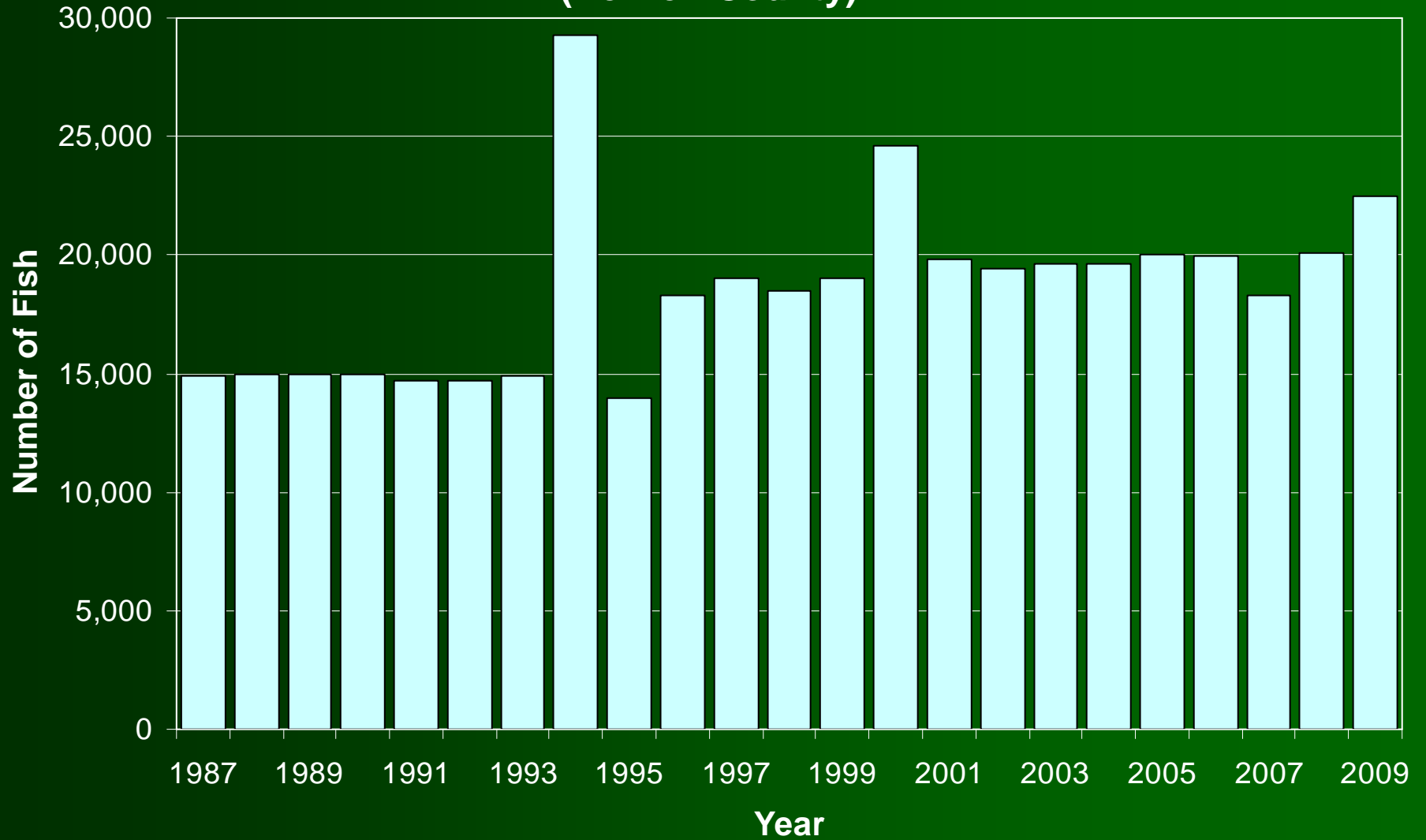
## Spring Fingerling Chinook Salmon Stocked in the St. Joseph River
