Class description:

Springtime is a great time to be in the woods and wild turkey hunting is among one of the most popular hunts in Michigan! There is nothing quite like hearing that first gobble as the day breaks! Taught by the National Wild Turkey Federation's Regional Director, Steve Sharp, this class will provide you with all the information you need to get started! The workshop will include discussion of season rules and regulations, habitat, scouting and patterning birds, hunting technique and equipment needed for turkey hunting. Learn the language of the wild turkey and how to use the various calls available on the market today.

At the end of the workshop, you will be given an opportunity to apply for your turkey permit online!

Class description:

Session One participants will meet at the Rose Lake Shooting Range and learn more in preparation for the spring turkey-hunting season! This session will focus on patterning your shotgun, ethical placement of shot and more calling practice! We will also explain how to dress your harvest properly and provide recipes!
