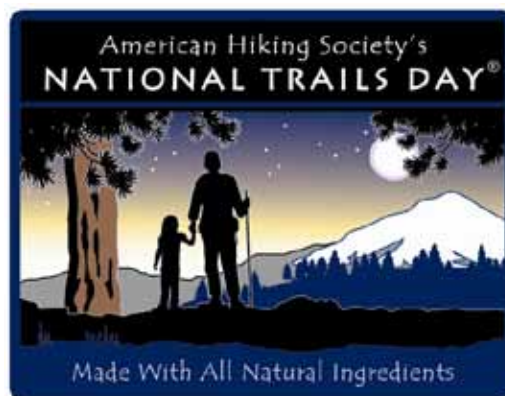

## Lower Falls Viewing Area

Hikers take a free shuttle from the Lower Falls to the trail head at the Upper Falls. Shuttle begins at 9:00 am and runs every thirty minutes. The last shuttle departs at 1:00 pm. Hikers may also pick up the shuttle at the Upper Falls to begin their hike from the Lower Falls trail head between 9 am - 1 pm.

The 5-mile River Trail parallels the Tahquamenon River, traversing through old-growth forest, giant cedars and hemlocks, and beautiful wildflowers.

North Country Trail volunteers will staff an info table and provide outdoor activities at the Lower Falls. The Upper Falls will also have activities and hands-on displays at the Fact Shack.



A Recreation Passport is required for all vehicles entering the park. Recreation Passports can be purchased through the Michigan Secretary of State or at the park entrance.
