

Request for Proposal (RFP) Michigan Department of Technology, Management and Budget (DTMB) for Michigan State Police (MSP) – Lakeview, Montcalm County SR #2017-0042

Questions & Answers January 17, 2017

Q. Would the State consider a larger space up to 10,000 square feet?

A. 6,068 square feet is the total square footage requested. Please see II.8 regarding Alternative Terms.

Q. Can a broker be paid by the landlord so long as there are no commission fees required to be paid by the tenant?

A. Proposals and pricing should be reflective of no broker commission fees.

Q. When is it anticipated the State will make a decision on the RFPs?

A. No timeline for a decision has been set.

Q. If a proposal is made for an existing building which is currently for sale, will the bidder have the right to withdraw their proposal before a final decision has been made?

A. All proposals shall be valid for one hundred twenty (120) days from the submission due date, unless mutually agreed to in writing by both parties.

Q. Would the State consider a modified gross or net lease for a stand-alone building as compared to the gross lease terms requested?

A. Please see II.8 of the RFP regarding Alternative Terms.

Q. Does the State have need for any warehouse space or overhead doors in addition to the office space requested?

A. The RFP is a request for office space. Please see II.8 regarding Alternative Terms.

Q. Is there further guidance on layout and finish requirements for the space?

A. Building standards are attached to the RFP.

Q. Is there further guidance on whether an existing facility will be considered? If so, any guidelines on the construction, dimensions, finishes?

A. Please refer back to the RFP. Building standards have been included and there is nothing in the RFP requiring a "new build".
