DTMB offers many IT Project Coordinator and Project Manager career opportunities. It is widely recognized within the information technology industry that portfolio, program, and project management are best practices that promote the delivery of on-time, on-budget systems that meets customer expectations.

As an IT Project Manager you will provide centralized management for one or more projects within a Program Management Office. Activities include identifying, prioritizing, authorizing, managing, and controlling projects and programs to achieve specific strategic business objectives.

There are three levels in the IT Project Manager classification series:

Information Technology Project Manager 13

As an IT Project Manager 13 you be responsible for serving as the project manager for one or more small, medium, or large projects.

Information Technology Project Manager 14

As an IT Project Manager 14 you will provide leadership for a program (group of multiple-related small, medium or large projects) or as the project manager for one or more large, high risk, highly visible and highly complex projects. You may also function as the portfolio manager for one or more agencies with information technology investments that include a mix of small, medium, and large projects.

Information Technology Project Manager 15

As an IT Project Manager 15 you will be responsible for one or more programs or one or more extremely complicated, high risk and very large projects. You will provide leadership and direction to the project functional team so that tasks and activities are coordinated to integrate with each other and are in congruence with the project plans and schedules.

QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify for an IT Project Coordinator position, you must possess a bachelor's degree with 21 semester (32 term) hours in computer science, data processing, computer information systems, data communications, networking, systems analysis, computer programming, project management, or mathematics.

As an **IT Project Manager 13** you will need four years of professional experience as a project coordinator for IT software or infrastructure projects involving 10 or more team members. Alternatively, you will need four years of professional experience equivalent to an IT Programmer/Analyst with experience managing a project with a size and scope typically less than 6 months in duration with 10 or more team members in addition to a minimum of 500 demonstrated and documented hours of coordinating software development or infrastructure projects.

As an **IT Project Manager 14** you will need five years of professional experience as a project manager for IT software or infrastructure projects involving 20 or more team members. Alternatively, you will need five years of professional experience equivalent to an IT Programmer/Analyst with experience managing a project/program typically 6 months to 2 years in duration with 20 or more team members in addition to a minimum of 1500 demonstrated and documented hours of coordinating IT software development or infrastructure projects. Possession of a PMP Certification is highly desired.

As an **IT Project Manager 15** you will need six years of professional experience as a project manager for IT software or infrastructure projects involving 50 or more team members. Alternatively, you will need six years of professional experience equivalent to an IT Programmer/Analyst with experience managing projects/programs typically greater than 2 years in duration with 50 or more team members in addition to a minimum of 4500 demonstrated and documented hours of managing IT software development and infrastructure projects. Possession of a PMP Certification is highly desired.
