eWebEditPro Upgrade/Changes Michigan.gov

- Upgrade Version from v2.0.0.28 to v2.6.0.7.
- Correct the font size in tables so that it will remain at the current standard of 2 (10 pt).
- Only add necessary tags and exclude additional formatting.
- Increased the number of allowed characters from 65,000 to 100,000.
- Added a Justify and Subscript function to the Format toolbar.
- The new version will also help to eliminate a browser crashing issue with IE 6.x and Windows 2000 that is a known issue with older version of eWebEditPro.

- We corrected the font size in tables so that the font size will remain at the current standard of 2 (10 pt).

- The new version of SurfAid will not add all of the extra formatting.
 - Old version v2.0.0.28:**

Increased Number of Allowed Characters Michigan.gov

- We increased the number of allowed characters from 65,000 to 100,000 to help prevent eWebEditPro from generating an error do to many characters.

Note: We discourage against using this many characters when ever possible.
