

EDUCATION ACHEIVEMENT AUTHORITY OF MICHIGAN

PROPOSED CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF SCHOOLS

2012-2013 SCHOOL YEAR

The rationale for the selection of the 2012-13 cohort is based on the premise that the schools with the highest percentage of at-risk students or in need of the greatest assistance should receive the first opportunity to become member schools in the EAA of Michigan. A rubric was developed that ranked schools based on a series of performance indicators including proficiency in reading and math, attendance, ACT, and graduation rates. Trend data was also reviewed for schools with similar rubric scores. Points were awarded as follows:

Bottom Quartile	1 point
Second Quartile	2 points
Third Quartile	3 points
Top Quartile	4 points

Note: In the case of ties, the school with greatest number of declines greater than one will receive priority.
