Dear CLECs and ILECs:

I am writing this letter to update you on the initiative to move towards the electronic process in the Telecommunications Division regarding regulated intrastate tariffs. As you may recall, the Division web page, in 2002, had an announcement encouraging all telecommunications providers to develop electronic web based tariffs by the beginning of 2003. To date, there are 22 ILECs with web-based tariffs and 10 CLECs with web based tariffs. This is a good start. However, I want to expand this to all ILECs and CLECs.

As of December 31, 2003, all ILECs and CLECs must have electronic web based tariffs for their existing regulated Michigan tariffs. Each company must also maintain this web site and provide us with the electronic address for the site so the tariffs can be linked to the Telecommunications Division web site. The goal is to eliminate all paper tariffs and paper tariff filings.
