


RABIES PROTOCOL FOR MAMMALS WHICH HAVE BITTEN PEOPLE OR PETS

*The following animals are NOT CONSIDERED LIKELY TO CARRY RABIES and will not be tested except by special arrangements with the Michigan Department of Community Health (517) 335-8165: (After 5:00 p.m. and on weekends dial (517) 335-9030)
