

Michigan Qualified Energy Conservation Bonds (QECB) Stakeholders Advisory Group

Public Input Process

An RFP process will be developed to communicate new objectives and selection criteria for allocating the full amount of QECBs that the state expects to receive soon through voluntary local waivers.

To insure public input, the MI Energy Office (MEO) is establishing an Advisory Group with representative stakeholder interests to assist with developing project selection criteria, streamlining the application/selection/financing process and ensuring that project outcomes are tracked and reported.

- Name, Organization, Title and Contact Information of the nominee. If you are nominating someone else, please include your contact information as well.
- Provide relevant information demonstrating the nominee's knowledge of a named stakeholder's interest (i.e. holds a leadership position in a stakeholder organization and/or has the support of peers from other stakeholder organizations.) Preference will be given to nominees recognized by multiple peer groups in addition to their own organization.
- Briefly describe nominee's relevant experience/general knowledge of energy waste reduction and renewable energy projects, programs and/or related financing approaches.
- Affirm nominee's commitment to meet with the QECB Advisory Group in Lansing (preferred) or by phone beginning in December, 2015 through July, 2016. Advisors are expected to be active participants in monthly or bi-monthly meetings, offering suggestions and providing input from peers.
