

2016 MI QECB Allocations

Request for Information

New Application Process

The Michigan Agency for Energy (MAE) with the Department of Treasury has issued a “Request for Information” (RFI). This RFI will provide MAE and Treasury with an understanding of the current demand for [Qualified Energy Conservation Bonds \(QECB\)](#) and preliminary information on potential projects. MAE and Treasury will not assign QECB allocations based on this information alone.

Communities and others eligible to receive a QECB allocation may submit a project profile that includes the following information to: Jan Patrick, Michigan Energy Office, PO Box 30221, Lansing MI 48909 or patrickj5@michigan.gov whenever ready. However, with the redistribution of waived allocations expected to begin early in 2016, it is recommended that project profiles be submitted by June 30, 2016 or before MI QECB allocations are fully committed, whichever occurs first. Information on submitting more detailed project applications will be posted at this site as soon as it’s available.
