*For foster care youth 18-24 years old (in care and aged out)*

- The services include: teeth cleaning, x-rays, head and neck examination, oral hygiene instruction, oral examination, fluoride treatment and dental sealants.
- Final diagnostic services are not provided.
- All dental services are provided at the WCCCD Dental Hygiene Clinic located at the Northwest campus.
- Dental Hygiene Clinic services are supervised by licensed dental hygienists and dentists.
- Prospective patients are required to complete a medical and dental history form provided by the dental hygiene clinic. A list of past and/or current medications is also required.
