The Prosecuting Attorneys Association of Michigan (PAAM) Child Abuse Training Services program, in cooperation with the Prosecuting Attorneys Coordinating Council, and the Department of Human Services (DHS), is pleased to present a state-wide cross-professional Specialized Child Abuse Training seminar on the topic of *Investigating the Dynamics of Child Prostitution and Encouraging Change*. This seminar will be held Thursday, August 11, 2011. The seminar will begin with registration at 9:00 a.m. and conclude by 4:30 p.m.

Three national speakers bring their expertise to you in this full day of working together to combat child prostitution.

Kevin Mulcahy will discuss investigating, charging and trying child prostitution cases. This program targets law enforcement, social workers and prosecutors in the challenges of handling criminal investigations into prostitution rings involving minors. From initiating investigations, to preparing for trial, to working with the child prostitutes who often do not see themselves as victims, this discussion will prepare you and your cases going forward.

Marc Klass will discuss human trafficking in the USA, the country's response, and how law enforcement and social service agencies can reassess priorities to address the reality of domestic human trafficking.

Chip St. Clair will be "inspiring C.H.A.N.G.E in today's youth". He will explore how you can curtail the negative behavior in troubled children and inspire them to change.
