Experienced supervisors may fall into a comfortable pattern of supervising and have little opportunity to be challenged toward growth. This seminar is designed for both experienced and new child welfare supervisors who want to learn or be reminded of an important foundation of supervisory approaches, framework and skills that are crucial to developing and supporting casework staff and assisting them in meeting child welfare outcomes.
