occupation Factory work, aged 50 years, do declare on oath that my personal description is:

color of hair brown, height 6 feet 6 inches, weight 160 pounds; visible distinctive marks

race German; nationality British
I was born in Marijampole, Baranov, Volhynia, Russia, June 27, 1887
I am married. The name of my wife or husband is Alvina (nrdt) Jeschke
we were married on January 28, 1909, at Marijampole, Volhynia, Russia. He was born at Marijampole, Russia, on September 19, 1892. He entered the United States under the name of Alvin Jeschke on August 15, 1909. He resides at 2109 Michigan Ave., Lansing, Mich. He has five children, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows:
Elsie, born Jan. 19, 1910 at Marijampole, Russia. Resides at Lansing, Mich.
Eugene, born July 19, 1911 at Marijampole, Russia. Resides at Lansing, Mich.

under the name of Jeschke, Reinhold on August 15, 1909


I will, before being admitted to citizenship, renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly, by name, to the prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty of which I may be at the time of admission a citizen or subject; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to reside permanently therein; and I certify that the photograph affixed to the duplicate and triplicate hereof is a likeness of me; So swear and Goo.

Subscribed and sworn to before me in the office of the Clerk of said Court, at Lansing, Michigan, this 25th day of August, 1909, and Donald Hec, Certification No. 24, 1909, from the Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization showing the lawful entry of the declarant for permanent residence on the date stated above, has been received by me. The photograph affixed to the duplicate and triplicate hereof is a likeness of the declarant.

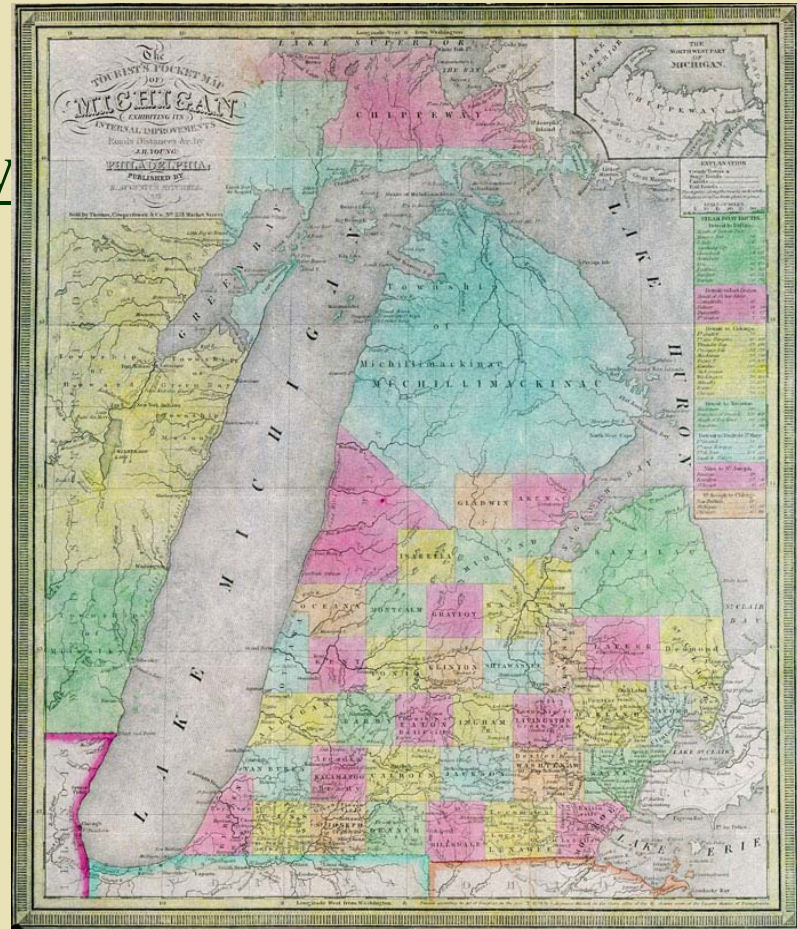
