

CONSTITUTION HALL

Exit I-496 at M.L. King Blvd. Turn onto northbound M.L. King Blvd. Turn right onto Allegan Street. Constitution Hall will be on your right (between Pine Street and Walnut Street).

Park in the lot at the front of the building (east side). This lot is operated by Ellis Parking and is accessible from Allegan and Washtenaw Streets. Bring your parking ticket inside, and it will be validated in class. All visitors must enter the building through the east doors. Uniformed security personnel check the identification of all people entering the building.
