Historical Reenactors portraying all time periods of Michigan History are invited to participate in the 2nd annual Walk Through Time event at Walker Tavern Historic Site on Saturday, June 27th. This is a one-day event from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. It offers a unique opportunity to compare and contrast encampments, activities, clothing and lifeways of different eras of Michigan History to see changes through time. Reenactors are invited to share their knowledge and passion for the past with the public and with each other.

Reenactors must be in character, and ready and able to interact with the public Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Those units who wish to camp at this 66 acre state historic park may do so Friday and Saturday nights. Firewood, straw, portapotties, and water are provided. Food will be available for purchase from on-site food vendors on Saturday and from the Farmers Market on Sunday 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Sunday there is a vintage baseball game at Walker at 1 p.m.
