Vendors are expected to wear historically appropriate dress and must be in character and ready and able to interact with the public Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Those who wish to camp at this 66 acre state historic park may do so Friday and Saturday nights. Firewood, straw, portapotties, and water are provided. Food will be available for purchase from on-site food vendors on Saturday and from the Farmers Market on Sunday 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Sunday there is a vintage baseball game at Walker at 1 p.m.
