TDSA's are areas that contain a concentration of people who identify with a tribe and in which there are organized and structured tribal activities, but they do not include a federally-recognized land base.

Only 5.1% of the Michigan residents who report an American Indian race* live in tribal areas, and only 1.3% of Michigan's total population reports an American Indian race.* The percentages of people reporting an American Indian race* are:

71.6%	Off-Reservation Trust Lands in Michigan
12.6%	American Indian Reservations in Michigan
2.4%	Michigan Portion of Pokagon TDSA
1.2%	Remainder of Michigan
