**GENERAL**

**R 18.351 Definitions.**

Rule 1. (1) As used in these rules:

- (a) "Accomplice" means any person who knowingly aids or assists another person in the commission of a crime, either before, during, or after the crime.
- (b) "Act" means 1976 PA 223, MCL 18.351 to 18.368.
- (c) "Civil infraction" has the meaning prescribed by section 6a of 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.6
- (d) "Closed session" means a meeting or part of a meeting of the commission which is closed to the public in order to protect certain rights of confidentiality.
- (e) "Crime" means an act or omission forbidden by law which is not designated as a civil infraction and which is punishable, upon conviction, by imprisonment, a fine which is not a civil fine, or other penal discipline.
- (f) "Criminally responsible" means legally accountable or legally answerable for a crime.
- (g) "Dependent" means a person who receives at least 1/2 of his or her support from a deceased victim or claimant and includes a child of the victim born after his or her death.
- (h) "Household" means persons who dwell together as a family under 1 roof and who are related by blood, marriage, or judicial decree.
- (i) "Intimate personal privacy" means matters dealing with the mental or physical health of a person or the details of a crime involving sexual assault in any degree.
- (j) "Legally incapacitated person" means a person, other than a minor, for whom a guardian has been appointed by a court.
- (k) "Loss of support" means the cessation of a victim's earnings that were actually paid to or for a dependent prior to the victim's death and not reimbursed from insurance or public funds after the victim's death.
- (l) "Meeting" means the convening of the commission at which 2 or more members are present for the purpose of deliberating toward or rendering a decision on a public policy.
- (m) "Minor" means a person who is less than 18 years of age.
- (n) "Other services necessary" means recognized medical treatment, convalescent aids, supplies, and other equipment needed by the victim because of physical incapacity sustained as a direct result of the crime.
- (o) "Peace officer" means an employee of this state, or any political subdivision thereof, who is employed as a police officer, sheriff, firefighter, conservation officer, or similar officer exercising powers of a police officer.

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(p) "Resident" means a person who is living in this state when the crime occurs. Resident does not include a person who resides in another state or foreign country and who is temporarily in this state for business, recreation, or personal matters.

(q) "Unreimbursed and unreimbursable expenses" means expenses for which the claimant has no means of payment other than the claimant's assets or through an award of the commission.

(r) "Writing" means any of the following:

(i) Handwriting.

(ii) Typewriting.

(iii) Printing.

(iv) Photostating.

(v) Photographing.

(vi) Photocopying.

(vii) Any other means of recording, including the recording of letters, words, pictures, sounds, symbols, or any combination thereof.

(viii) Maps.

(ix) Papers.

(x) Magnetic or punched cards.

(xi) Discs.

(xii) Drums.

(xiii) Any other means of recording or retaining meaningful contents.

(2) Terms defined in the act have the same meanings when used in these rules.

**R 18.354 Claim filing time.**

Rule 4. A claim is subject to the time limits for filing which are set forth in section 5 of the act; however, if a claim is filed after the time limits in section 5 of the act, the commission may presume that good cause to file a claim late exists unless contrary evidence exists.

**R 18.355 Claimant cooperation with law enforcement agency and board required; claimant to bear burden of proof of authenticity and eligibility of claim.**

Rule 5. (1) To receive an award, a claimant shall cooperate with the law enforcement agency investigating the crime giving rise to the claim and with the investigators, agents, and representatives of the commission. If a claimant refuses to cooperate, the commission may deny the claim or reduce the size of any award.

(2) The final burden of proof of the authenticity and eligibility of a claim, or any part of a claim, rests with the claimant. When an award cannot be made because the law enforcement agency, medical providers, or employer cannot verify the claim, the claimant shall be given written notice of the particular deficiencies of verification. The information requested by the commission as necessary to verify the claim shall be supplied by the claimant. If the claimant does not comply within a reasonable period of time, the claim shall be denied in whole or in part as appropriate.

(3) Health Care providers cannot bill a sexual assault victim for any portion of a Sexual Assault Forensic Examination (SAFE).

(4) A Peace Officer is one who sustains a personal physical injury, which means bodily harm as a result of an assault in the course of employment.

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**R 18.358 Payment limitations.**

Rule 8. (1) When an award is ordered for funeral expenses, including burial expenses, the commission shall pay a burial benefit of not more than \$2,000 for each victim for the date of injury on or before December 15, 2010 and not more than the amount set forth in section 11 of the act for each victim for the date of injury on or after December 16, 2010.

(2) Expenses for flowers, gravestones, catering services, or other personal and family accommodations not directly related to the funeral service and disposition of the body will not be considered.

(3) When the commission awards funeral expenses, which in the absence of commission payment, would be receivable from other public funds, the amount awarded shall not exceed the amount normally paid by the other sources.

(4) The commission shall not award more than the amount set forth in section 11 of the act for grief counseling for homicide victim's spouse, children, parents, siblings, grandparents, and grandchildren.

(5) The commission shall not award more than the amount set forth in section 11 of the act for crime scene clean-up services as allowed under the act.

Rule 11. (1) In determining serious financial hardship under section 11 (7) of the act, the commission shall consider all of the financial resources of the claimant.

(2) In all cases, the commission shall render a decision which will, as nearly as practicable, permit the claimant or family to maintain a reasonable standard of living. Where out-of-pocket expenses or loss of earnings or support significantly lower this standard of living, the commission may consider this serious financial hardship.

**FIREWORKS SAFETY GENERAL RULES**

**PART 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

**R 29.2901 Applicability.**

Rule 1. These rules shall apply to all new and existing permanent buildings or structures and temporary facilities at which both consumer and low-impact fireworks are sold.

**R 29.2902 Definitions.**

Rule 2. As used in these rules:

- (a) "Act" means the Michigan fireworks safety act, 2011 PA 256, MCL 28.451 to 28.471.
- (b) "Bureau" means the department of licensing and regulatory affairs' bureau of fire services.
- (c) "Department" means the department of licensing and regulatory affairs.
- (d) "NFPA" means the standard established by the national fire protection association headquartered at 1 Batterymarch Park, Quincy, Massachusetts.
- (e) "National holidays" as identified in section 7(2) of the act, means national holidays as defined in 5 U.S.C. 6103 (1998).
- (f) "Permanent building or structure" means both of the following:
  - (i) Stores.
  - (ii) Consumers fireworks retail sales (cfrs) facilities, as defined by nfpa 1124 (2006 edition).
- (g) "Temporary facilities" means a building or structure not meeting the definition for a permanent building or structure, at which consumer and low-impact fireworks are sold, including the following:
  - (i) Consumer fireworks retail stands.
  - (ii) Tents.
  - (iii) Canopies.
  - (iv) Membrane structures.

**R 29.2903 Applications.**

Rule 3. The bureau shall create uniform applications and other forms for dissemination to and for use by applicants for retail sales and local units of government as provided under section 16 of the act and published in electronic format at <http://www.michigan.gov/bfs>. Applications for retail sales may be submitted after January 1 of the calendar year for which the certificate will be issued.

**R 29.2904 Affidavit of compliance.**

Rule 4. An affidavit of compliance under section 18(b) of the act shall be submitted by any applicant applying for a consumer fireworks certificate. The affidavit shall state that the individual applicant requesting the certificate has not been convicted of a felony involving theft, fraud, or arson or any felony conviction within the preceding 5 years.

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**R 29.2905 Collection of fees.**

Rule 5. The bureau shall create procedures for the collection of applications and fireworks safety fees in accordance with the act, the Michigan department of treasury rules and procedures, and department of licensing and regulatory affairs tax and finance procedures, including the following:

(a) Pursuant to sections 8 and 9 of the act, a person who sells consumer fireworks, low-impact fireworks, or both at retail locations shall collect the 6% fireworks safety fee when the gross retail income is \$1.04 or more as determined before any taxes are applied. This fee shall be in addition to the 6% Michigan state sales tax. A person who fails to collect and remit the fireworks safety fee shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$10,000. A person who is found guilty under section 18c of the act shall not be eligible to obtain a consumer fireworks certificate for the specified time period.

(b) Pursuant to section 10 of the act, the remittance of the fireworks safety fee shall be filed with the department on forms prescribed by the department within 15 business days after the end of each calendar quarter (March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31 of each year). The forms and submission schedule are published in electronic format at <http://www.michigan.gov/bfs>.

(c) Fireworks safety fees and requisite filing forms shall be postmarked by the filing date and mailed to: Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Fire Services, P.O. Box 30642, 7150 Harris Drive, Lansing, MI 48909. Checks or money orders shall be payable to the state of Michigan.

**R 29.2906 Transfer of certificate.**

Rule 6. A consumer fireworks certificate shall be transferrable to another entity in accordance with section 4(6) of the act. A new applicant shall submit an application and other required information, other than plans, with a \$25 transfer fee. The consumer fireworks certificate may only be transferred to a new entity that is in the same physical location and that has had no modifications made to the facility since the last required inspection.

Rule 7. An applicant shall be eligible for a refund of 80% of the application fee if a written notice of cancellation for a certificate is received by the bureau prior to the completion of the site inspection. The notice shall be signed by the applicant and state that the applicant acknowledges that the certificate, if already issued, is void.

Rule 8. The bureau shall establish an inspection process to confirm that the retail location meets the requirements of the act and the national codes and standards as adopted by reference in R 29.2909 for the retail sale of consumer fireworks. The state fire marshal or the state fire marshal's designee may enter and inspect the retail locations issued a consumer fireworks certificate at any reasonable time.

**R 29.2912 Definitions.**

Rule 12. Sections 3.2.2, 3.2.3, 3.3.19, 3.3.30, 3.3.30.1, 3.3.30.2, 3.3.48, 3.3.51, and 3.3.52 are amended and sections 3.2.3.1, 3.3.30.3, 3.3.30.4, 3.3.65.1, and 3.3.78 are added to read as follows:

3.2.2 “Authority having jurisdiction” means the director of the department or an employee of the department appointed by the director to implement the act.

3.2.3 “Code” means the national fire protection association pamphlet no. 1124, 2006 edition, entitled “code for the manufacture, transportation, storage, and retail sales of fireworks and pyrotechnic articles” as amended by these rules.

3.2.3.1 “Act” means 2011 PA 256, the Michigan fireworks safety act, MCL 28.451 to 28.471.

3.3.19 “Consumer fireworks retail stand” means a temporary or permanent building or structure that has a floor area not greater than 800 sq. ft. (74 sq. m.), other than tents, canopies, or membrane structures, that is used primarily for the retail display and sale of consumer fireworks to the public. Stands may include, but are not limited to, small buildings, plywood and sheet metal structures, manufactured buildings, semitrailers, shipping containers, or similar structures or facilities.

3.3.30 “Firework or fireworks” means any composition or device, except for a starting pistol, a flare gun, or a flare, designed for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, deflagration, or detonation. Fireworks consist of consumer fireworks, low-impact fireworks, articles pyrotechnic, display fireworks, and special effects.

3.3.30.2 “Display fireworks” means large fireworks devices that are explosive materials intended for use in fireworks displays and designed to produce visible or audible effects by combustion, deflagration, or detonation, as provided in 27 CFR 555.11, 49 CFR 172, and APA standard 87-1, 4.1.

3.3.30.3 “Low-impact fireworks” means ground and handheld sparkling devices as that phrase is defined under APA standard 87-1, 3.1, 3.1.1.1 to 3.1.1.8, and 3.5.

3.3.30.4 “Special effects” means a combination of chemical elements or chemical compounds capable of burning independently of the oxygen of the atmosphere and designed and intended to produce an audible, visual, mechanical, or thermal effect as an integral part of a motion picture, radio, television, theatrical, or opera production or live entertainment.

3.3.48 “Novelties” means devices as defined under APA standard 87-1, 3.2, 3.2.1, 3.2.2, 3.2.3, 3.2.4, and 3.2.5 and all of the following:

(a) Toy plastic or paper caps for toy pistols in sheets, strips, rolls, or individual caps containing not more than .25 of a grain of explosive content per cap, in packages labeled to indicate the maximum explosive content per cap.

(b) Toy pistols, toy cannons, toy canes, toy trick noisemakers, and toy guns in which toy caps, as described in subdivision (a) of this rule, are used that are constructed so that the hand cannot come in contact with the cap when in place for the explosion, and that are not designed to break apart or be separated to form a missile by the explosion.

(c) Flitter sparklers in paper tubes not exceeding 1/8 inch in diameter.

(d) Toy snakes not containing mercury, if packed in cardboard boxes with not more than 12 pieces per box for retail sale and if the manufacturer’s name and the quantity contained in each box are printed on the box; and toy smoke devices.

3.3.51 “Permanent building or structure” means a building or structure that is affixed to a foundation on a site that has fixed utility connections and that is intended to remain on the site for more than 180 consecutive calendar days.

3.3.52 “Person” means an individual, agent, association, charitable organization, company, limited liability company, corporation, labor organization, legal representative, partnership, unincorporated organization, or any other legal or commercial entity.

3.3.65.1 “Retailer” means a person who sells consumer fireworks or low-impact fireworks for resale to an individual for ultimate use.

3.3.78 “Minor” means an individual who is less than 18 year of age.

**R 29.2913 Retail sales of consumer fireworks**

Rule 13. Sections 7.2.1, 7.3.2, 7.3.3.3, 7.3.6, 7.3.13, 7.3.16, 7.3.18.1, 7.3.23, 7.4.9.1.1, 7.4.9.2.4, 7.5.1.1, 7.6.2.2 of chapter 7 of the code are amended, section 7.3.13.1 is added, and sections 7.3.18.2 and 7.4.9.2.1 of the code are deleted to read as follows:

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7.2.1 Retail sales of consumer fireworks, including their related storage and display for sale of such fireworks, shall be in accordance with this code and the act.

7.3.2 Consumer fireworks certificate. A consumer fireworks certificate shall be obtained in accordance with the act and these rules.

7.3.3 Plans. Plans shall be submitted at the time of application. Plans for permanent and temporary facilities shall be drawn in a professional manner on suitable material. Electronic media plans shall be acceptable. Plans shall be of sufficient detail and clarity to show the following as applicable:

- (1) Minimum distances from the following:
  - (a) Public ways.
  - (b) Buildings.
  - (c) Other cfrs facilities.
  - (d) Motor vehicle fuel-dispensing station dispensers.
  - (e) Retail propane-dispensing station dispensers.
  - (f) Flammable and combustible liquid above-ground tank storage.
  - (g) Flammable gas and flammable liquefied gas bulk above-ground storage and dispensing areas within 300 ft. (91.5 m) of the facility used for the retail sales of consumer fireworks.
- (2) Vehicle access and parking areas.
- (3) Location and type of portable extinguishers.
- (4) Floor plan and layout of storage and displays to indicate compliance with this chapter including aisles, proposed flame break locations and construction, and proposed shelving materials.
- (5) Means of egress.
- (6) Construction details for structures and fire-rated construction for required walls.
- (7) The maximum expected quantity of pyrotechnic material on display and maximum expected quantity of pyrotechnic material stored on site.

A copy of the plans required by this rule shall be provided by the applicant to the local fire department at the time of application for use in pre-incident review and planning.

7.3.6 An automatic sprinkler system designed and installed in accordance with ordinary hazard group 2 for ceiling heights under 16 feet (4.9m) or in accordance with extra hazard group 1 for ceiling heights 16 feet (4.9m) or above under nfpa 13, standard for the installation of sprinkler systems, shall be provided within 1 year of the effective date of the act, for the following permanent cfrs facilities and stores in which cfrs are conducted:

- (1) New buildings greater than 6000 sq. ft. (557.2 m<sup>2</sup>) in area.
- (2) Existing buildings greater than 7500 sq. ft. (694 m<sup>2</sup>) in area.

7.3.13 Fire safety and evacuation plan. For a cfrs facility or store, a fire safety and evacuation plan shall be prepared in writing, maintained current, and available for inspection upon request.

7.3.13.1 The fire safety and evacuation plan shall include, but not be limited to, the following information:

- (1) The procedure for reporting a fire or other emergency.
- (2) The procedure for alerting occupants of a fire or other emergency.
- (3) Emergency egress floor plans indicating all exits, manual fire alarm boxes, portable extinguishers, and fire alarm panels and controls.
- (4) A list of fire hazards associated with the normal products in the facility, including maintenance, general fire safety, and housekeeping practices.
- (5) The procedure to ensure all employees receive initial and on-going training in their responsibilities under the fire safety and evacuation plan.

7.3.16 Electrical equipment. All electrical wiring shall be in accordance with the Michigan electrical code, R 408.30801 to R 408.30880.

7.3.18.1 Fuel for generators shall be permitted to be class I, class II or class III liquids and shall be limited to not more than 5 gallons (18.9L).

7.3.18.2 Deleted.

7.4.9.2.1 Deleted.

7.4.9.1.1 Temporary wiring installed in a temporary structure, including tents and canopies, shall comply with the Michigan electrical code.

7.4.9.2.4 Where the generator fuel storage is located not less than 50 ft (15.2m) from the cfrs facility, the quantity of such fuel shall not be limited by 7.3.18.

7.5.1.1 For the purpose of this chapter, stores in which retail sales of consumer fireworks are conducted shall not be considered cfrs facilities as defined in 3.3.29.1 where both of the following conditions exist:

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(1) The area of the retail sales floor occupied by the retail displays of consumer fireworks does not exceed 25 percent of the area of the retail sales floor in the building or 600 ft<sup>2</sup> (55.5 m<sup>2</sup>), whichever is less.

(2) The consumer fireworks are displayed and sold in a manner consistent with the applicable provisions of this code, federal law, and the act.

7.6.2.2 Fire safety and evacuation plan. For a temporary cfrs stand, a fire safety and evacuation plan in compliance with section 7.3.13.1 shall be prepared in writing, maintained current, and available for inspection upon request.

**R 29.2914 Verification of compliance.**

Rule 14. Consumer fireworks shall not be sold at a retail location until the bureau verifies compliance with section 5 of the act, nfpa 1124, and these rules. Verification may be accomplished by either of the following:

(a) A site inspection of the retail location by the bureau. The bureau shall be the authority having jurisdiction to enforce the applicable nfpa codes. A person shall request an inspection for compliance in accordance with this rule by writing to the Bureau of Fire Services, Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, P.O. Box 30700, 525 W. Allegan, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Lansing, MI 48909.

(b) Submission of a notarized affidavit signed by the person filing the certificate application stating that the certified retail location will be in compliance with section 5 of the act, nfpa 1124, and these rules, and that plans have been submitted in accordance with R 29.2913 of these rules, prior to selling consumer fireworks. The affidavit shall be submitted for each retail location simultaneously with the application for a consumer fireworks certificate.

**PART 3. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES**

**R 29.2915 Violations.**

Rule 15. If the bureau determines during the physical site inspection that violations exist, the person holding the certificate for the retail location shall be responsible for a civil fines pursuant to the act and rule 16 of these rules. The bureau may seize fireworks pursuant to section 14(2) of the act for failure to pay any fine within the time written on the violation notice.

**R 29.2916 Sanctions.**

Rule 16. The bureau may issue violation citations and assess civil infraction fines and penalties for any violations of the act and applicable rules, including those observed by bureau personnel while they are performing their duties. The bureau may enforce violation citations and civil infraction fines and penalties pursuant to the department's obligation to administer the requirements of the act. When bureau personnel determine a violation of the act or applicable rules exists, these violations shall be stated on a violation citation form prescribed by section 17a of the act and copy of the citation shall be submitted to the state fire marshal.

Rule 17. A person applying for a consumer fireworks certificate under the act may be subject to any and all penalties as prescribed by the act. The bureau may forward information regarding violations of the act subject to potential criminal sanctions to the prosecutor for the jurisdiction in which the alleged violation of the act has occurred.

Rule 18. Proof of insurance as required by section 5(3) of the act shall be in writing, be current, and be available for inspection upon request at each retail location.

Rule 19. A person denied a certificate for a retail location may file an appeal in writing with the state fire marshal within 28 calendar days of the issuance of the denial. An appeal of a certificate denial shall be based on the following technical review procedure within 28 calendar days of receipt:

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(a) The state fire marshal, or the state fire marshal's designee, shall conduct a technical review of the certificate denial and decide the matter based on the interested parties' written submissions and documents, bureau records, applicable rules, and the state fire marshal's technical expertise.

(b) The state fire marshal is not authorized to conduct a hearing.

(c) The state fire marshal shall issue a technical review decision setting forth the state fire marshal's material findings of fact, conclusions of law, and remedial orders, if any.

The technical review decision of the state fire marshal shall be deemed to be final department action for purposes of judicial review under chapter 4 of the administrative procedures act, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.271 to 24.287.

**R 29.2920 Appeal of violation citation or civil infraction penalty or fine.**

Rule 20. Any party wishing to appeal the violation citation, any penalty or fine assessed for such violation, or both shall file within 28 calendar days of issuance of the violation citation an appeal with the state fire marshal. An appeal of the violation citation does not automatically stay a party's obligation to take action necessary to remedy the violation. The appeal process shall consist of the following:

(a) The state fire marshal, or the state fire marshal's designee, shall conduct a review of the violation citation appeal and decide the matter based on the interested parties' written submissions and documents, bureau records, applicable rules, and the state fire marshal's technical expertise.

(b) The state fire marshal is not authorized to conduct a hearing.

(c) Within 28 calendar days of issuance of the violation citation, the state fire marshal, or the state fire marshal's designee, shall issue a review decision setting forth the material findings of fact, conclusions of law, and remedial orders, if any. The review decision of the state fire marshal, or the state fire marshal's designee, shall contain notice of the right of interested parties to file an appeal to the state fire safety board within 28 calendar days of issuance.

**R 29.2921 Waiver of hearing; acknowledgement of violation.**

Rule 21. A party issued a certificate for a retail location cited for a violation of the act or applicable rules may waive the right to appeal and acknowledge the violation or violations specified in the citation. The waiver of the right to appeal and acknowledgement of the violation shall be in accordance with section 17a of the act. The certificate holder may explain, on a separate sheet of paper, any mitigating circumstances which the certificate holder believes should be considered in disposing of the violation.

**R 29.2922 Appeal of state fire marshal's review decision to the state fire safety board.**

Rule 22. An interested party to the review proceeding may file an appeal of the state fire marshal's final review decision under R 29.2920 of these rules to the state fire safety board within 28 calendar days of the issuance of the final review decision. The appeal process shall consist of the following:

(a) The state fire safety board shall conduct a technical review of the state fire marshal's final review decision and decide the matter based solely on the administrative record created by the state fire marshal.

(b) The state fire safety board is not authorized to conduct a contested hearing.

(c) The state fire safety board shall issue a decision setting forth its material findings of fact, conclusions of law, and remedial orders, if any, after official action by the state fire safety board at a regularly scheduled or special meeting.

(d) The decision of the state fire safety board shall contain notice of the right of interested parties to file an appeal to the Michigan administrative hearings system (mahs) within 28 calendar days of issuance of the board's decision.

**R 29.2924 Proposed decision of administrative law judge.**

Rule 24. The proposed decision of the administrative law judge shall be as follows:

(a) Within 10 business days of the conclusion of a hearing or within 5 business days of the receipt of the transcript, if any, or the additional time as allowed by the administrative law judge, each party may file with the administrative law judge a

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proposed order, including proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, with the supporting argument and reasoning as are necessary to support the proposed order.

(b) Within 20 business days of the conclusion of a hearing or within 15 business days of the receipt of the transcript, if any, the administrative law judge shall serve upon parties by certified mail or personal service a proposed decision which shall include all of the following:

(i) A statement of the reasons for the proposed decision.

(ii) Issues of fact and law necessary for the proposed decision.

(iii) The decision of the administrative law judge which shall be based upon consideration of the whole record and shall be made on the basis of a preponderance of reliable and probative evidence.

(c) Unless a party, within 10 business days of the receipt of the proposed decision, files exceptions to the proposed decision with supporting reasons, the proposed decision shall become a final decision of the director of the department. Exceptions shall refer to the specific issues of fact and law, or excepted terms of the proposed decision. If the testimony had been transcribed, reference shall be made to specific pages of the transcript, and shall suggest modified issues of fact and law, and terms of the proposed decision.

(d) An administrative law judge's proposed decision under this rule shall not be operative while that decision is being referred to the director.

Rule 25. If exceptions and objections are filed, the administrative law judge shall transmit the record of the proceeding to the director of the department. The record shall include the following:

(c) Evidence presented.

(d) Matters officially noticed, except matters so obvious that a statement of them would not serve a useful purpose.

(e) Proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, and exceptions and objections to them.

(f) Any proposed decision, opinion, order, or report by the administrative law judge.

The decision may affirm, modify, or set aside, in whole or in part, the findings, conclusions, and the rule or order contained in the proposed decision of the administrative law judge, and shall include a statement of reasons for each conclusion of law, supporting authority, or reasoned opinion. The director shall serve or cause to be served, a copy of the decision upon all parties and the hearing officer. The director's decision shall be deemed to be final department action for purposes of judicial review under chapter 4 of the administrative procedures act, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.271 to 24.287.

**R 54.201 Definitions.**

Rule 1. (1) As used in these rules:

- (a) "Act" means the state survey and remonumentation act, 1990 PA 345, MCL 54.261 to 54.279.
- (b) "Applicant" means a county or multiple counties that apply for a grant pursuant to the act.
- (c) "Application" means an annual grant application pursuant to section 13 of the act.
- (d) "Annual grant agreement" means the contract between the department and an applicant.
- (e) "Corner code" means the designation given a corner based on its location within the surveyed township as established on the form pursuant to R 339.17403(8).
- (f) "Department" means the department of licensing and regulatory affairs.
- (g) "Grant administrator" means a person who is appointed by the county board of commissioners.
- (h) "Grantee" means an applicant that receives a grant pursuant to the act.
- (i) "Land corner recordation certificate" (LCRC) means the document prepared and filed pursuant to the corner recordation act, 1970 PA 74, MCL 54.201 to 54.210d, and the form prescribed in R 339.17403(7).
- (j) "Monument" means a marker that occupies the position of a corner and that possesses, or is made to possess, a magnetic field, or is set pursuant to the corner recordation act, 1970 PA 74, MCL 54.201 to 54.210d.
- (k) "Monumentation" means the process by which a public land survey corner or property controlling corner position was established and monumented in an original survey or resurvey by the United States government.
- (l) "Peer review group" means the advisory panel of surveyors who review and provide advice on corners presented by surveyors.
- (m) "Public land survey corner" means any corner actually established and monumented in an original survey or resurvey used as a basis of legal description for issuing a patent for the land to a private person from the United States government.
- (n) "Remonumentation" means all land surveying activities performed by a surveyor to perpetuate a remonumentation corner pursuant to the act.
- (o) "Remonumentation corner" means a public land survey corner or a property controlling corner established and monumented in an original survey or resurvey by the United States government, being perpetuated pursuant to the act and these rules.
- (p) "Remonumentation surveyor" means the licensed professional surveyor who is awarded a contract, by a grantee, to perform remonumentation of remonumentation corners.
- (q) "Standard monument" means any monument defined in a county plan.
- (r) "Surveyor" means a professional surveyor licensed under article 20 of the occupational code, 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.2001 to 339.2014.

(2) Terms defined in the act have the same meanings when used in these rules.

Rule 4. The county plan shall include all of the following:

- (a) A remonumentation plan that identifies and itemizes all remonumentation corners within the borders established by the county plan, including the borders, by county, surveyed township and range, and corner code.
- (b) A survey history for each county and copies of records that identify United States government surveys that were conducted outside the instructions for deputy surveyors issued by the surveyors general in 1815, 1833, and 1850.
- (c) Define each county's standard monuments to be used when it is necessary to set a new monument pursuant to the act and these rules.
- (d) Outline the specific requirements when remonumentation work is completed by a surveyor for both of the following:
  - (i) Setting a standard monument,
  - (ii) Accepting an existing monument.
- (e) Stipulate that copies of all remonumentation records required to be maintained and filed pursuant to sections 8(2)(b) and 8(2)(c) of the act shall be provided to the department upon request.
- (f) Provide for a perpetual monument maintenance plan pursuant to the act, which shall initiate the year following determination by the department that the remonumentation plan in subdivision (a) of this rule has been completed, pursuant to section 14(2) of the act.
- (g) Only be amended with the approval of both the board of county commissioners and the department.

**R 54.205 Grant administrator.**

Rule 5. (1) The grant administrator shall do all of the following:

- (a) Manage a grantee's obligations of the annual grant agreement and be the point of contact.
  - (b) Be responsible for the application, all reports, and documentation required by the act, these rules, and the annual grant agreement.
  - (c) Oversee the county representative and all contractual obligations to fulfill the annual grant agreement.
- (2) If the grant administrator is also the county representative, that individual and that individual's organization shall not enter into any remonumentation surveyor contract within the borders established by the county plan.

**R 54.206 County representative.**

Rule 6. (1) A county representative of each county shall be the county representative for all surveying projects approved by or initiated through the department pursuant to the act. When necessary, a deputy county surveyor may be appointed pursuant to revised statutes of 1846, county surveyors, or an alternative county representative may be appointed by the county board of commissioners to serve in the absence of the county representative.

(2) A county representative shall do all of the following:

- (a) Assist the applicant and grantee by providing technical and professional expertise.
- (b) Assist the applicant and grantee in the development of and monitoring the progress of their county plan pursuant to the act and these rules.
- (c) Coordinate the perpetuation of remonumentation corners along shared county borders.
- (d) Facilitate the inclusion of any remonumentation corners that were not included in the annual grant agreement.
- (e) If a peer review group has been established, schedule and chair the meetings pursuant to the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275, and give notice to any surveyor who has a position in conflict with a corner position scheduled for peer review.
- (f) At the discretion of the grantee, provide an indication of acceptance on the LCRC that the corner record has been reviewed by the peer review group and accepted by the grantee to be filed with the state pursuant to the act, these rules, and the annual grant agreement. The indication of acceptance shall be placed on the face of the LCRC before its filing with a county's register of deeds. If a conclusive decision cannot be made on a remonumentation corner, the surveyor or grantee may request an independent review be completed before the surveyor renders a final decision.

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(3) If the county representative is also the grant administrator, that individual and that individual's organization shall not enter into any remonumentation surveyor contract within

**R 54.207 Peer review group.**

Rule 7. (1) A grantee may establish a peer review group of surveyors to review corners presented before filing.

(2) The peer review group shall consist of a minimum of 3 members, which includes the chair.

(3) The peer review group shall include not more than 1 person from any firm or company.

(4) All meetings shall be held in compliance with the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.

Rule 8. (1) An applicant shall comply with the requirements of section 14 of the act and these rules by appointing a grant administrator.

(2) The department may approve or deny applications based on either the following criteria:

(a) Corners to be completed or maintained.

(b) Estimated expenditures.

(3) The department may require the applicant to provide additional information for the department to make a determination required by the act and these rules.

(4) The department may solicit legal or technical review of an application from other sources.

(5) Approved applications shall be forwarded to the director of the department for execution of an annual grant agreement if sufficient funds are available.

Rule 9. The department shall disburse an annual grant pursuant to section 12 of the act and as follows:

(b) Forty-five percent of the annual grant amount upon receipt and approval of a progress report and supporting documentation. The total of the start-up payment and progress payment is limited to 85% of the total annual grant.

(c) Final payment upon receipt and approval of a completion report and supporting documentation.

Rule 10. A grant may be revoked in whole or in part pursuant to the act, these rules, and the annual grant agreement.

Rule 12. (1) The department may audit the grantee to assure compliance with the requirements of the grant agreement.

(2) The grantee shall retain all financial records, supporting documents, statistical records, and all other records that are pertinent to a grant for a period of 5 years, unless any litigation or departmental audit is started before the expiration of the 5-year period. Records shall be retained for 7 years from the date of the audit report or until all litigation, claims, or audit findings that involve the records have been resolved, whichever is later.
