The newsletter contained state approved content and Penny wants the Board to consider using the NABP to create a newsletter for Michigan, by use of a grant, through NABP, for a year. After the year, the Board can petition for another grant. Penny will get more information about costs.

Penny stated that the Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination (MPJE) will hold an Item Development workshop March 15-16, 2016. These sessions consist of a didactic item-writing instruction session followed by guided item development. They are held at the NABP Headquarters in Mt. Prospect, Illinois. Penny also mentioned that there is a grant available for 1 person.

Penny then mentioned that the Annual NABP meeting will be in San Diego, California, May 14-17, 2016. She said that there are grants available and encouraged Board members to contact her if they are interested.
