



On September 24, 2015, the Bureau of Community and Health Systems issued an *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent to Revoke* the adult foster care family home license of Jack Johnson.

In settlement of all issues raised in the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent to Revoke*, the undersigned parties hereby agree:

- 1) Jack Johnson neither admits nor denies that the specific allegations set forth in the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent to Revoke* occurred; however, he admits that at least one violation of the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act, 1979 PA 218, has occurred.
- 2) Jack Johnson understands that his adult foster care family home license will be revoked, effective the date of the signature by the representative of the Bureau of Community and Health Systems.
- 3) Jack Johnson understands that he is waiving his right to appeal the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent to Revoke* and a hearing will not be held in this matter.
- 4) Jack Johnson agrees not to apply for an Adult Foster Care license for a period of five years from the effective date of the summary suspension.
