2. TDDK, Inc., 450-452 W Western, Muskegon, Muskegon County

The licensing hearing for TDDK, Inc., Request ID# 225197, was tabled from the December 13, 2011 appeal hearing of the Commission. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Tom Harris and David Harris, stockholders, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Hall and Mr. T. Harris offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, it was moved by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to affirm the previous order of the Commission dated October 26, 2011 denying the request for extension of time beyond 5 licensing years for the 2010 Class C license with Dance Permit, motion carried by unanimous vote.

The licensing hearing was conducted for Slocum's Gifts, Décor and More, LLC, Request ID# 578605. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney R.
