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Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:06 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Southfield Appeal Hearings of January 10, 2013, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Ellana, Inc., D/B/A New Mr. Sam's Food Center, 7459 Joy, Detroit, Wayne County Business ID# 169673

The penalty hearing was conducted for Ellana, Inc., Business ID# 169673. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Marshal Garmo and Neal Edward, manager, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Asevedo, Mr. Garmo and Mr. Edward offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to suspend the license for 10 days as set forth in the Penalty Hearing Order, with the suspension being served starting Friday, January 25, 2012 and stopping Sunday, February 3, 2013. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. New Pancho's, LLC, 4127 Fifteen Mile, Sterling Heights, Macomb County Request ID# 654127

The licensing hearing was conducted for New Pancho's, LLC, Request ID# 654127. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Eric Bryen, Nadda Sheleh and Amani A. Nagi, stockholders, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo, Mr. Bryen, Ms. Nagi and Ms. Sheleh offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated October 31,

2012, and approve the request to transfer ownership of 2012 Class C license with

Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) from Pancho's Villa's, L.L.C. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. P&P Party Store, LLC, 33091 W. Jefferson, Brownstown, Brownstown Township, Wayne County Request ID# 558065

The licensing hearing was conducted for P&P Party Store, LLC, Request ID# 558065. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Denise Proudlock, stockholder and Alan Proudlock, husband of stockholder appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo, Ms. Proudlock and Mr. Proudlock offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to affirm, the previous Commission Order of denial dated October 17, 2012, for a request for new Specially Designated Distributor license with Sunday Sales (P.M.) to be held in conjunction with existing 2012 Specially Designated Merchant license with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.). Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

5. Rob-Dar, Inc., 4331 E. Huron, North Branch, Lapeer County Request ID# 668941

The show cause hearing was conducted for Rob-Dar, Inc., Request ID# 668941. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Paul Overland, stockholder and Sally Overland, wife of stockholder appeared on behalf of Rob-Dar, Inc. Mr. Asevedo and Mr. Overland offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, the Commission finds that as the licensee has demonstrated that there is a pending sale, the licensee showed good cause to remain licensed. Chairman Deloney made a motion that Mr. Overland can hold the current stock interest until the escrowed licenses are sold or terminated, with the licenses to remain in escrow as set forth in the Show Cause Hearing Order. Commissioner Olshove supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:40 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
