1. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from January 10, 2012, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Star 9, Inc., 2381 Apple, Muskegon, Muskegon Township, Muskegon County

The penalty hearing was conducted for Star 9, Inc., Business ID# 143868. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney David Bowen and Jack Vander Meulen, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Hall, Mr. Bowen and Mr. Vander Meulen offered comments regarding this case.
