Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:05 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from January 24, 2012, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Slocum's Gifts, Décor and More, LLC, 111 Main, Buchanan, Berrien County Request ID# 578605

The licensing hearing was conducted for Slocum's Gifts, Décor and More, LLC, Request ID# 578605 which was tabled from the January 10, 2012 docket. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and no one appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Hall offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, it was moved by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Quimby, to reverse the previous Commission Order dated September 28, 2011, and approve the request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license.

3. Bayview Grille, LLC, 727 Main, Frankfort, Benzie County Request ID# 615747

The licensing hearing was conducted for Bayview Grille, LLC, Request ID# 615747. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Matthew Classens and member, Dale Evans, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Chief of Police Keith Redder was present for the City of Frankfort. Mr. Hall, Mr. Classens, Mr. Evans and Chief Redder offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, it was moved by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, that the previous Commission Order dated November 9, 2011, be reversed and the transfer ownership of escrowed 2011 Class C and

Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (PM) and Specific Purpose Permit (Food), from R M O'Brien, LLC; and transfer location under MCL 436.1531(1) from 6535 First, Lake Ann, Benzie County; be approved.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:21 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
