Commissioner Quimby called the hearings to order at 10:06 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal Hearings of December 11, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Fakhoury, Inc., d/b/a Liquor King, G-3169 W Pasadena, Flint, Flint Township Genesee County Business ID# 167713

The penalty hearing was conducted for Fakhoury, Inc., Business ID# 167713. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Roger Isaac, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Hall and Mr. Isaac offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion to suspend the license for ten (10) consecutive days as set forth in the Penalty Hearing Order, with the starting date of the suspension being, Monday, January 14, 2013. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. JK Liquors Inc, 1392 E M-89, Otsego, Otsego Township, Allegan County Request ID# 667438

The licensing hearing was conducted for JK Liquors Inc, Request ID# 667438. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Attorney Michael Brown appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Hall and Mr. Brown offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated November 28, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of escrowed 2012 Specially Designated Distributor

license only with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), from Rite Aid of Michigan, Inc., to be held in conjunction with proposed new Specially Designated Merchant license, and transfer location. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. S.H.J. Agency, Inc., 3311 W Carleton, Hillsdale, Hillsdale County
Request ID# 623632

The licensing hearing was conducted for S.H.J. Agency, Inc., Request ID# 634321. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney David L. Taylor and sole stockholder David Gadelkarim, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Hall, Mr. Taylor and Mr. Gadelkarim offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby advised this matter would be tabled for a hearing on a future date.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:43 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
