Commissioner Quimby called the hearings to order at 10:03 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal hearing of October 9, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Ottomatic, Inc., 104 S Main, Wayland, Allegan County Request ID# 633999

The licensing hearing was conducted for Ottomatic, Inc., Request ID# 633999, which was tabled from the Lansing Appeal Hearings held on September 25, 2012. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and stockholder Josh Otto appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Mary Kaye Bennett, current license holder. Ms. Hetzel and Mr. Otto offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated August 3, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership 2012 B-Hotel and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), Dance Permit and Specific Purpose Permit (Food), from Wayland Hotel, Inc. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Restaurant 01-31-12, L.L.C., 5710 Harvey, Muskegon, Fruitport Township, Muskegon County Request ID# 655259

The licensing hearing was conducted for Restaurant 01-31-12, L.L.C., Request ID# 655259, which was tabled from the Lansing Appeal Hearings held on October 2, 2012. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney

Michael Brower appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel and Mr. Brower offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated September 12, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership escrowed 2012 Resort Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), Specific Purpose Permit (Food) and Outdoor Service Permit from Team R N'B Wisconsin, LLC; cancel Specially Designated Merchant license held in conjunction and cancel Specific Purpose Permit (Food). Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:14 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
