The licensing hearing was conducted for Fleetwood Bar & Grill, LLC, Request ID# 610479. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office; Attorney Kenneth Hoogeboom and Ashraf Karadsheh appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler and Mr. Hoogeboom offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, a motion was made by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the previous order of the Commission dated September 20, 2011, be rescinded and that the request to transfer ownership of escrowed 2011 Class C license with Sunday Sales permit (P.M.), Dance-Entertainment permit and two (2) Bars from Salsa Night Club, Inc.; to transfer location of governmental unit; cancel existing Dance-Entertainment permit; request new Official Permit (Food); request for new outdoor service area permit; be approved, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
