1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to approve the Southfield Appeal minutes from September 22, 2011 and October 13, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.

The following licensing appeal was tabled from the Southfield Appeal Hearing on September 22, 2011. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and Attorney Peter Abbo appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo and Mr. Abbo offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Order of the Commission dated August 10, 2011, which denied the request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license with motor vehicle fuel pumps and approve the license. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote

The following licensing appeal was tabled from the Southfield Appeal Hearing on September 1, 2011. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and Attorney Thomas J. Giachino appeared on behalf of the applicant. Marsha Bruhn, President, North Rosedale Civic Association, spoke in opposition. Mr. Asevedo, Mr. Giachino, and Ms. Bruhn offered comments regarding this case. After discussion

on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Order of the Commission dated July 27, 2011, which denied the request to transfer ownership of the escrowed 2000 Specially Designated Distributor license with Sunday Sales Permit (PM) from J.A.M.B. Enterprises, Ltd., and transfer location from 5330 Wyoming, Detroit, Wayne County, to be held in conjunction with existing Specially Designated Merchant license and approve the transfer. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:26 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
