Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:08 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from October 18, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Crist Investment Company Inc., 201 W Chicago, Jonesville, Hillsdale County Request ID# 570467

The licensing hearing was conducted for Crist Investment Company Inc., Request ID# 570467. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Brown and Rex Crist, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler, Mr. Brown and Mr. Crist offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the Order of the Commission dated September 20, 2011, and approved the request to transfer ownership of 2011 Specially Designated Merchant license with motor vehicle fuel pumps pursuant to MCL 436.1541(3) from The Colotti Group LLC. Supported by Commissioner Quimby, the motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. Scooters Airport Bar, LLC, 4520 N Clare, Harrison, Hayes Township, Clare County Request ID# 579185

The licensing hearing was conducted for Scooters Airport Bar, LLC, Request ID# 579185. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, stockholder Daryl Martin appeared on behalf of the applicant with his wife, Tiffany Bourguet-Martin, also present. Mr. Geissler, Mr. Martin and Mrs. Martin offered

comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the Order of the Commission dated August 31, 2011, and approved the request to transfer ownership of 2011 Class C license with Sunday Sales permit (P.M.) and dance-entertainment permit from JML, LLC. Supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Angela Lane, 754 Calumet, Twin Lake MI Request for new Salesperson License

The licensing hearing for Angela Lane was tabled from the August 30, 2011 appeal hearing of the Commission. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Ms. Lane was not present. Mr. Geissler offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the Order of the Commission dated May 10, 2011, and approve the request for a new Salesperson license. Supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
