Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:05 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to approve the Southfield Appeal minutes from October 20, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. ZJM, Inc., 9045 Mac Arthur, Ypsilanti, Superior Township, Washtenaw County Request ID #568421

The licensing hearing was conducted for ZJM, Inc., Request ID # 568421. Adam Rubin appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and Ms. Ghada Husein appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Rubin and Ms. Husein offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the previous Order of the Commission, dated June 8, 2011, be rescinded and the request for an extension of escrow until April 30, 2012 for the 2010 Specially Designated Distributor and the Specially Designated Merchant licenses, be approved. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote

3. Moody River Ventures LLC, 1560 E. Elm, Monroe, Monroe County Request ID # 556810

The licensing hearing was conducted for Moody River Ventures LLC, Request ID # 556810. Adam Rubin appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and Attorney Kerry Bondy appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Rubin and Ms. Bondy offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the previous Order of the Commission, dated September 20, 2011, be rescinded and the request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license with permit to sell alcoholic liquor between 7:00 am and 12:00 noon on Sundays and motor vehicle fuel pumps. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. LAX Club Hanger, LLC, 22-24 W Adams & 2nd Floor 18-24 W Adams, Detroit,
Wayne County Request ID #581066

The church hearing was conducted for LAX Club Hanger, Request ID #581066. Melinda Leonard appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Rev. Edwin A. Rowe appeared on behalf of Central United Methodist Church and Tonya Cunningham appeared on behalf of LAX Club Hanger, LLC. A motion was made by Ms. Cunningham to adjourn the hearing to give the applicant's counsel better time to prepare. The church supported the motion of adjournment in order to obtain counsel. After discussion on the record, the decision was made to grant the request to adjourn and to table the matter until Thursday, November 3, 2011 at 10:00 am.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:10 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
