Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:13 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Chairman Deloney, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal Hearings of October 16, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Murk's Village Market, Inc., 8337 M-140, South Haven, South Haven Township, Van Buren County Request ID# 621707

The licensing hearing was conducted for Murk's Village Market, Inc., Request ID# 621707, which was tabled from the Lansing Appeal hearing held on March 13, 2012. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Christopher Baker and President Steve Murks, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel and Mr. Baker offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to affirm the previous Commission Order of denial dated December 29, 2011, and to deny the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to add space and request a second Direct Connection in conjunction with 2012 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M. & P.M.) one (1) Direct Connection and Motor Vehicle Fuel Pumps. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Country Pub Inc., 150 Main, Gregory, Unadilla Township, Livingston County Request ID# 616988

The licensing hearing was conducted for Country Pub Inc., Requests ID# 616988. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Robert F.

Taylor appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel and Mr. Taylor offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commissioner Order of denial dated September 25, 2012, and to approve the request to transfer stock as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, in the 2012 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), Specific Purpose Permit (Food), Dance Permit and Entertainment Permit (without Dressing Rooms). Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Bruce A. Patulski and Miriam L. Patulski Estate, 2377 Water, Stronach, Stronach Township, Manistee County Business ID# 10132

The licensing hearing was conducted for Bruce A. Patulski and Miriam L. Patulski (Estate), Business ID# 10132. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Josh Reece and Bruce A. Patulski, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Attorney Patrick Dougherty appeared on behalf of Miriam L. Patulski Estate. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Reece and Mr. Dougherty offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised the matter would be tabled for a hearing at a future date.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Chairman Deloney, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:54 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
