1. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from September 27, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Sherry and David Schrader, 9538 W Long Lake, Alpena, Alpena Township, Alpena County Request ID# 608690

The licensing hearing for Sherry and David Schrader, Request ID# 608690 was tabled from the Lansing Appeal Hearing held on September 13, 2011. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and no one appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, a motion was made by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the previous order of the Commission dated July 27, 2011, be rescinded and that the request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.) be approved, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Harrington's West Bay, LLC, 13890 S West Bay Shore, Traverse City, Grand Traverse County Request ID# 611416

The licensing hearing was conducted for Harrington's West Bay, LLC, Request ID# 611416. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office; Attorney Matthew Classens, members Glen Harrington and John McGee appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler, Mr. Classens, Mr. Harrington & Mr. McGee offered

comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, a motion was made by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, that the previous order of the Commission dated August 3, 2011, be rescinded and that the request to transfer ownership of 2011 Resort Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), Outdoor Service Permit (1 area) and Official Permit (Food) from Schelde Enterprises, Inc., and request for a new Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.), be approved, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
