Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:05 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to approve the Southfield Appeal minutes from September 29, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. 7-Eleven, Inc. (A Texas Corporation) and Vaishnav Enterprises, Inc., 7171 N. Canton Center, Canton, Wayne County Business ID# 10203

The penalty hearing was conducted for 7-Eleven, Inc., (A Texas Corporation) and Vaishnav Enterprises, Inc., Business ID# 10203. Melinda Leonard appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorneys Steve Ormond and Harold Wolkind, and Mr. and Mrs. Vaishnav appeared on behalf of the licensees. Ms Leonard, Mr. Ormond, Mr. Wolkind, Mr. Vaishnav and Mrs. Vaishnav offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to suspend the license for ten days and waive 5 days of the suspension. This suspension would start on October 14, 2011 and conclude on October 18, 2011. The waived dates are October 19, 2011 through October 23, 2011. Commissioner Weatherspoon supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the Commission dated July 13, 2011, and approve the request to transfer ownership of the 2011 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (PM)

from Awni, Inc. Commissioner Weatherspoon supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Carrollton Store, Inc., 3777 N. Michigan, Saginaw, Saginaw County,
