Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:19 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Southfield Appeal Hearing of October 25, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. 643 Telegraph, LLC, 643 Telegraph, Monroe, Monroe County
Request ID#486253

The licensing hearing was conducted for 643 Telegraph, LLC, Request ID# 486253. Linda Pytel-McDowell appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Kelly Allen and Fawzi Simon, sole member, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms Pytel-McDowell and Ms. Allen offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated September 12, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, for a new Specially Designated Merchant license with permission for motor vehicle fuel pumps on or adjacent to the licensed premises under MCL 436.1541(1). Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Messi, Inc., 3980 Crooks, Rochester Hills, Oakland County
 - A. SDM – Request ID# 659108
 - B. SDD – Request ID# 659109

The licensing hearings were conducted for Messi, Inc., Request ID# 659108 (SDM) and Request ID# 659109 (SDD). Linda Pytel-McDowell appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Joseph A. Shallal appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Steve Haisha, representative for the fuel company which would be providing product to the applicant. Ms. Pytel-McDowell and Mr.

Shallal offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Orders of denials, both dated September 19, 2012, and to approve the two requests as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Orders, for a new Specially Designated Merchant license with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.) and permission for motor vehicle fuel pumps on or adjacent to licensed premises under MCL 436.1541(1) and for a new Specially Designated Distributor license with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) and permission for motor vehicle fuel pumps on or adjacent to licensed premises under MCL 436.1541(1). Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Trio's Entertainment, Inc., D/B/A Oscar's Bar, 11850 Livernois, Detroit, Wayne County Business ID# 140732

The show cause hearing was conducted for Trio's Entertainment, Inc., Business ID# 140732, which was tabled from the Southfield Appeal Hearing held on July 19, 2012. Linda Pytel-McDowell appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney David R. Draper appeared on behalf of licensee and Sherman Givhan, sole member, appeared on behalf of applicant, Trio's Entertainment, LLC. Ms. Pytel-McDowell and Mr. Draper offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the findings of the Commission are that applicant, Trios Entertainment, LLC, has shown good cause as to why they signed the renewal applications, and the Commission advised they can move forward with their application. Commissioner Quimby supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:46 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
