Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:04 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal Hearings of October 30, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Bud & Elsie's #8, L.L.C., 3112 Oakland, Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County Request ID# 630663

The licensing hearing was conducted for Bud & Elsie's #8, L.L.C., Request ID# 630663. Gerald Whalen appeared on behalf of the Attorney General's Office, Attorney Owen Ramey and member Brian Lipner, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Whalen and Mr. Ramey offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated September 26, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of 2012 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M. & P.M.) and Beer & Wine Sampling Permit, from Shoot the Moon, Inc. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. JAI MAA, Inc., 10418 Shaver, Portage, Kalamazoo County Request ID# 421317

The licensing hearing was conducted for JAI MAA, Inc., Request ID# 421317. Gerald Whalen appeared on behalf of the Attorney General's Office, Attorney John Doyle and stockholder Darmesh Rajpoot appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Whalen and Mr. Doyle offered comments regarding this case.

The hearing was recessed at 10:23 a.m.

The hearing reconvened at 10:32 a.m. Present were Chairman Deloney, Commissioner Quimby and Commissioner Olshove.
