Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:03 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from November 1, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.

2. Todblid LLC, 104 E May, Mt Pleasant, Isabella County Request ID# 426668

The licensing hearing was conducted for Todblid LLC, Request ID# 426668. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Todd Gurzick, member, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler and Mr. Gurzick offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the previous Order of the Commission dated January 12, 2011, be affirmed and the request for a new Specially Designated Distributor license with authorization for the sale of spirits for consumption off the premises on Sunday after 12:00 noon, to be held in conjunction with an existing Specially Designated Merchant license, be denied. Supported by Commissioner Quimby, the motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. Austin Rental & Convenience Store LLC, 1314 Lansing, Jackson, Jackson County Request ID# 579239

The licensing hearing was conducted for Austin Rental & Convenience Store LLC, Request ID# 4579239. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Tina Austin, member, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler and Ms. Austin offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the previous Order of the

Commission dated October 19, 2011, be rescinded and the request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.) and permission to maintain four (4) Direct Connections to unlicensed premises, be approved. Supported by Commissioner Quimby, the motion carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:18 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
