Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:02 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal Hearings of November 20, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Gursidos, Inc., 4107 Red Arrow, Stevensville, Lincoln Township, Berrien County Request ID# 663132

The licensing hearing was conducted for Gursidos, Inc., Request ID# 663132. Gerald Whalen appeared on behalf of the Attorney General's Office, Attorney Jack Struwin and applicant stockholder Rajbir Singh, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Whalen, Mr. Struwin and Mr. Singh offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated October 10, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer all stock interest in Specially Designated Merchant license with motor vehicle fuel pumps on or adjacent to the licensed premises under MCL 436.1541(5). Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. The Stray Dog Limited Partnership, 203 W Buffalo, New Buffalo, Berrien County Request ID# 314922

The licensing hearing was conducted for The Stray Dog Limited Partnership, Request ID# 314922. Gerald Whalen appeared on behalf of the Attorney General's Office, Attorney David Barbour and managing member Leslie Danesi, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Whalen, Mr. Struwin and Ms. Danesi offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a

motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated September 26, 2012, and to approve the extension of the escrow period to June 30, 2013, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, for the 2012 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Levneff Properties L.L.C., 9501 Ferris, Springport, Springport Township, Jackson County Request ID# 630373

The Show Cause hearing was conducted for Levneff Properties L.L.C., Request ID# 630373. Gerald Whalen appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and member Wesley Levering appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Whalen and Mr. Levering offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the licensee, Levneff Properties L.L.C., has shown good cause as to why the complete conviction record of member Wesley Levering, was not reported to the Commission, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Supported by Commissioner Quimby, motion carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:20 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
