Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:07 a.m., noting that a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from November 22, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.

2. Parmjot Ventures, LLC, 5030 S Ninth, Kalamazoo, Texas Township, Kalamazoo County A) SDM – Request ID# 615314 B) SDD – Request ID# 615315

The licensing hearings were conducted for Parmjot Ventures, LLC, Request ID#'s 615314 and 615315. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Charanjit Singh, member, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Leon Boone was present in support of Mr. Singh. Mr. Geissler and Mr. Singh offered comments regarding the facts of the case. Mr. Boone asked to provide a comment in support of the applicant and was allowed to do so. After discussion on the record, a motion was made by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commission Weatherspoon, that the previous order of the Commission dated September 28, 2011 be rescinded and that the requests for a new Specially Designated Merchant license and a new Specially Designated Distributor license with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), be approved; motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. Holmberg Inc., 100 S Second, Manistique, Schoolcraft County
Request ID# 619640

The licensing hearing was conducted for Holmberg Inc., Request ID# 619640. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Gary Olsen and Tori Henry, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler, Mr. Olsen and Ms. Henry offered comments regarding this case. After

discussion on the record, a motion was made by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, that the previous order of the Commission dated October 26, 2011, be rescinded and that the request to transfer ownership of the 2011 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) and Dance Entertainment Permit from Northern Exposure of Michigan Ltd., and request a new Entertainment Permit and new Official Permit (Food), be approved; the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:51 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
