1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from December 6, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Slocum's Gifts, Décor and More, LLC, 111 Main, Buchanan, Berrien County

This hearing was postponed at the request of the applicant.

3. TDDK, Inc., 450-452 W Western, Muskegon, Muskegon County

The licensing hearing was conducted for TDDK, Inc., Request ID# 225197. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Tom Harris and David Harris, stockholders, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Hall, Mr. T. Harris and Mr. D. Harris offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, it was moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to table this matter for further review, motion carried by unanimous vote.

4. SF+SF, LLC, 56607 Angevine, Mendon, Nottawa Township, St Joseph County

At a licensing hearing held on Tuesday, December 6, 2011, where the Commission reversed, in part, the Commission Order of Approval, dated May 4, 2011, regarding the provision that Penny Fenwick be allowed to participate in the business; the Commission inadvertently did not include the removal of the Age Verification Equipment provision. Therefore, a motion was made by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to amend, in part, the Commission Order of Approval dated May 4, 2011, by removing the requirement for the Specially Designated Merchant licensee to purchase Age Verification Equipment for each cash register at this location, motion carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:53 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
