Commissioner Quimby called the hearings to order at 10:00 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from November 29, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. SF+SF, LLC, 56607 Angevine, Mendon, Nottawa Township, St Joseph County

The licensing hearing was conducted for SF+SF, LLC, Request ID# 576435, was tabled from the Lansing Appeal Hearing held on November 22, 2011. Jerry Whalen appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and no one appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Whalen offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, a motion was made by Commissioner Quimby to reverse, in part, the Commission Order of Approval, dated May 4, 2011, regarding the provision that Penny Fenwick, wife of applicant, be allowed to participate in the business, but not in any matters relating to alcoholic liquor, which includes wine, beer and spirits. Supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. San Miguel Market, LLC, 5623 109<sup>th</sup>, Pullman, Lee Township, Allegan County

The licensing hearing was conducted for San Miguel Market, LLC, Request ID# 572722. Jerry Whalen appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and no

one was present on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Whalen offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby moved to affirm the Commission Order dated September 28, 2011, denying the request for a new Specially Designated Merchant license. Commissioner Weatherspoon supported, the motion carried by unanimous vote.
