Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:07 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal Hearings of February 5, 2013, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Vik, Inc., 649 Clancy NE, Grand Rapids, Kent County Request ID# 634321

The licensing hearing was conducted for Vik, Inc., Request ID# 634321, which was tabled from December 11, 2012, and January 15, 2013 hearings. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Brown and stockholder Vikramjit Singh, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Ms. Hetzel presented a brief summary of the case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated October 23, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of the escrowed 2012 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) from Chemical Bank.

2. Cavette Enterprises, Inc., 6801 N Saginaw, Flint, Genesee County
Request ID# 659712

The church hearing was conducted for Cavette Enterprises, Inc., Request ID# 659712. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Roger Isaac and Jerry Cavette, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Pastor Tom Veruys and Vice Chairman Dennis Rouse appeared on

behalf of Flint First Wesleyan Church. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Isaac, Mr. Cavette, Pastor Veruys and Mr. Rouse offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised the hearings would be recessed at 11:10 a.m.

The hearings reconvened at 11:26 a.m. Present were Chairman Deloney, Commissioner Quimby and Commissioner Olshove.

Chairman Deloney advised the findings of the Commission are as follows: that Flint First Wesleyan Church did file a proper objection to the transfer location of the 2012 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licensed business, and in this hearing, the Commission, under administrative rule R 436.1959, determined that the applicant had the burden of proceeding and had to show by competent, material and substantial evidence that a waiver of MCL 436.1503 would NOT adversely impact the operation of the objecting church. Further, Chairman Deloney made a motion that based on the findings of the Commission, it is concluded that the applicant has shown by competent, material and substantial evidence that a waiver of MCL 436.1503 would NOT adversely impact the operation of the objecting church. The motion was supported by Commissioner Olshove, motion carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:33 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
