The licensing hearing was conducted for Roger W. Duford, Request ID# 566024. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Thomas Pezzetti and Roger W. Duford, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler, Mr. Pezzetti, and Mr. Duford offered comments regarding this case.
