Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:08 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from February 21, 2012, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Blarney Castle Oil Co., 3576 Heights Ravenna, Muskegon, Fruitport Township, Muskegon County Request ID# 533373

The show cause hearing was conducted for Blarney Castle Oil Co., Request ID# 533373. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Dennis McCarthy appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Hall and Mr. McCarthy offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, it was moved by Chairman Deloney that the findings of the Commission are that the licensee has shown good cause as to why the inventory amount dropped below the minimum and so the licenses should not be cancelled; and the licensee is advised if an audit is conducted and the inventory amount is below \$250,000.00, the Commission has the right to terminate the license. Commissioner Quimby supported, motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. Blarney Castle Oil Co., 3003 Whitehall, Muskegon, Dalton Township, Muskegon County Request ID# 533368

The show cause hearing was conducted for Blarney Castle Oil Co., Request ID# 533368. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Dennis McCarthy appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Hall and Mr. McCarthy offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, it was moved by Chairman Deloney that the findings of the Commission are that the licensee has

shown good cause as to why the inventory amount dropped below the minimum and so the licenses should not be cancelled; and the licensee is advised if an audit is conducted and the inventory amount is below \$250,000.00, the Commission has the right to terminate the license. Commissioner Weatherspoon supported, motion carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:28 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
