Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:13 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from March 13, 2012, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Manani, Inc., d/b/a Howard Party Store, 1366 Portage, Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County Business ID# 158690

The penalty hearing was conducted for Manani, Inc., Business ID# 158690. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Owen Ramey and Karnail Singh were present on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Geissler, Mr. Ramey and Mr. Singh offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to suspend the license for 10 consecutive days, starting on Friday, March 23, 2012 through April 1, 2012. Commissioner Quimby supported, motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. Sensible Savage, Inc., 1344 Thirteen, Mass City, Greenland Township, Ontonagon County Request ID# 607291

The licensing hearing was conducted for Sensible Savage, Inc., Request ID# 607291. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Jesse Monville appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler and Mr. Monville offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order dated February 8, 2012 and approve the request to transfer ownership of escrowed 2011 B-Hotel and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales (P.M.), Dance and Living Quarters Permits from Sully's of Bergland, Inc.; transfer location from 100

Railroad, Bergland, Bergland Township, Ontonagon County; cancel existing Living Quarters Permit and Dance Permit; transfer classification to a Class C license; and request new Specific Purpose Permit (Food). Commissioner Weatherspoon supported, motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. Blanchard Lanes and Sports Bar LLC, R 2, 58 Jackson, Blanchard, Millbrook Township, Mecosta County Request ID# 614134

The licensing hearing was conducted for Blanchard Lanes and Sports Bar LLC, Request ID# 614134. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Chad Paulsen and Patricia Hicks appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Geissler, Mr. Paulsen and Mrs. Hicks offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order dated January 11, 2012 and approve the request to transfer ownership of 2011 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales (P.M.), from Patricia R. Hicks; and request new Outdoor Service approval. Commissioner Weatherspoon supported, motion carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:20 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
