Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:05 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal Hearings of February 26, 2013, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Bruce A. Patulski and Miriam L. Patulski Estate, 2377 Water, Stronach, Stronach Township, Manistee County Business ID# 10132

The show cause hearing was conducted for Bruce A. Patulski and Miriam L. Patulski (Estate), Business ID# 10132, which was tabled from the Appeal Hearing held on October 30, 2012. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Brown and Bruce A. Patulski, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Ms. Hetzel and Mr. Brown offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, the Commission finds that the concerns regarding the 2012 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses, and the permission for operating gas pumps, were satisfactorily addressed. Chairman Deloney made a motion that said licenses will not be revoked, as set forth in the Show Cause Hearing Order. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Phongtran, LLC, 912 E Cork, Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County Request ID# 672037

The licensing hearing was conducted for Phongtran, LLC, Request ID# 672037. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Brown and sole member Phong T. Tran, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Brown and Mr. Tran offered comments regarding this case. After

discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated January 16, 2013, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of escrowed 2012 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M. & P.M.) from B & S Party Store, Inc., and request to add space to the licensed premises. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Barno's, LLC, 1157 W Fulton, Grand Rapids, Kent County Request ID# 671456

The licensing hearing was conducted for Barno's, LLC, Requests ID# 671456. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Keith McEvoy and sole member Steve Barno appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel and Mr. McEvoy offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commissioner Order of denial dated January 16, 2013, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of 2012 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (A.M. & P.M.), from Stars Beverage, LLC. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

5. Port City Hospitality, LLC, 2033-2037 E Laketon, Muskegon, Muskegon Township, Muskegon County Request ID# 670246

The licensing hearing was conducted for Port City Hospitality, LLC, Request ID# 670246. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and Debora Douglas, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel and Ms. Douglas offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated February 6, 2013, and remand the application back to the licensing division for further review, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

6. Sabrina Jo Laurent, dba Busy Bee Bar, 514 N Mitchell, Cadillac, Wexford County Business ID# 142990 Request ID# 676834

The show cause hearing was conducted for Sabrina Jo Laurent, Business ID# 142990, Request ID# 676834. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and licensee Sabrina Jo Laurent, appeared on behalf of herself. Also present was Assistant Attorney General, Jason Geissler and ex-husband,

Gregory Laurent. Ms. Hetzel, Mrs. Laurent and Mr. Laurent offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the 2012 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), remain in escrow until an application for transfer ownership is approved by the Commission, as set forth in the Show Cause Hearing Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:22 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
