2. Panda King Express of Holland, L.L.C., 816 Lincoln, Holland, Ottawa County Request ID# 633106

The Church hearing was conducted for Panda King Express of Holland, L.L.C., Request ID# 633106. Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Noeng Chau appeared on behalf of the applicant and Mr. Terry Helgren, Administrative Pastor, appeared on behalf of Lakeshore House of Prayer. Mr. Hall, Mr. Chau and Mr. Helgren offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that it be the finding of fact of the Commission that the Lakeshore House of Prayer filed a proper objection to the granting of the Specially Designated Distributor license and that the applicant, Panda King Express of Holland, L.L.C., has demonstrated by showing competent, material evidence that the establishment would not provide a detrimental impact to the objecting church, and the application should proceed with no impediment, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, and motion carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:38 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
